The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical personnel to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of evidence to substantiate allegations of neglect to the 2-year-old child and his 4-year-old sibling by their mother. The Medical Examiner's Office determined that the 2-year-old child died as a result of ingesting prescription medication. The child's 4-year-old sibling was deemed unsafe, taken into Temporary Physical Custody, and placed in out-of-home care. The case remained open for ongoing case management services.
