Incident Description:
The father called 911 because the baby was unresponsive following a fall from the bed onto the floor. According to the father, the infant was sleeping in the car seat on the bed and was then found on the floor with the car seat on top of her. The child was taken to Children's Hospital by paramedics where she was found to have multiple fractures to the occipital bone, a skull fracture, intracranial hemorrhage, respiratory distress and evidence of a brain injury that is not consistent with a fall. The father admitted to throwing the baby across the room into a wall. He has been arrested and is being held with criminal charges pending.
