

## **eWiSACWIS Release 2.7 Pre-Release Summary TOP 15 Scheduled for Release on March 26th 2007**

Within this document you will find the release summary of eWiSACWIS (Release 2.7) TOP 15 system changes and enhancements. This summary includes changes that may impact workflow, data entry, procedures and reporting. Some of the changes may have been the result of a policy change while others may have been the result of PEP decisions. Many of the changes are the result of issues reported to the helpdesk by system users. The purpose of this information is to provide users with an overview of the information in a eWiSACWIS Release before it is released. "How Do I" and "Quick Reference" guides should continue to be accessed for more specific usage of the application and/or new functionality.

Incidents and Enhancements**

ID	eWiSACWIS Topic	Program Area	Description
20515	AFCARS	All	The AFCARS Tickler logic will be modified to prevent ticklers for children who are in an adult or youth correctional facility. The tickler production will resume at the previously established timeline once a child returns to placement from these types of facilities.
<b>6024</b>	<b>Approvals</b>	<b>All</b>	<b>Supervisors will be allowed to edit work that has been sent to them for approval without needing to have an assignment to the case and without having to return the work to the worker.</b>
21695	Assessment	Assessment	The CW Report Template will now prefill Child Welfare Assessment Contacts (a New Case note type) into the Contacts section of the CW report.
21271	Automated Messaging	All	Counties will now have the ability to modify distribution lists and even turn off certain messages that they do not find beneficial. Counties can contact the helpdesk or assigned Program Team member to request a modification.
6617	CPS Reports	Access	The date and time of screening decision made will be a user entered field. The date cannot precede the actual date and time report received and cannot be a future date.
21755	Document Plans	Ongoing	Fixes an issue where the Permanency Plan tickler was not being generated. The tickler is now generated as expected upon approval of a removal out of home placement.
20496	Eligibility	Eligibility	Gives Eligibility specialists the ability to void a IV-E line without creating a new one.
22124	Maintain Case	Adoption	Copied MA records will correctly display on the Adoptive case. The "No Rows Found" error will cease to exist.
21644	Case Visual Metaphor	All	Rate Settings will display "nested" under the placements. This includes all possible view scenarios (Search and all Desktop views). Currently rate settings only display off the Case.
21646	Merge Person	All	In order to facilitate the clean-up of person records, the edit that currently prevents the merging of persons attached to an investigation, will be removed.
21487	Mobile Computing	All	Ongoing Model (FA & CP and the CPE) functionality will be add to eWiSACWIS Anywhere.

10334	Person Management	All	Background Information Disclosure (HFS-64) is a requirement under the Wisconsin Caregiver Background Check Law: The acronym BID will be included as a 'type' under the Background Check tab, in the Person Management window.
21697	Search	All	The sensitivity given to 'Medium' on the precision bar will be reduced to allow search to find more the names that are close to what was searched.
21844	Template Mapping	Assessment	For the Child Welfare Report, the worker field will prefill the name of the worker that created the document AND the supervisor field will prefill the name of the worker's supervisor. The name will no longer change to the worker who launched the document instead of the worker who created the document.
21837	Imaging	All	The State has implemented imaging functionality similar to that currently used in the State of Alaska ORCA application to support storing and categorizing of images such as participant photos and legal documents related to case and case participants. Images will be received as electronic files in any of the following formats: .bmp, .jpg, .rtf, .doc, .xls, .pdf, and .html.
