Topic

Incident Number & Description

Access

- (23647) On the Access Report page, an address field was added to display the reporter's address under the Reporter group box on the Participant tab. This will no longer require access workers to go to the Person Management page to view the reporter's address.

The address field will list the reporter's work address. If no work address is documented for the reporter, it will then list the reporter's primary address, then the most recent address.

- (25296) This enhancement modifies Response Time values to be consistent with the current standards. In doing that, the question "Are there any present danger threats?" is followed by Yes and No radio buttons. Upon selecting Yes, a pop-up page will appear on the Narrative tab of the Access Report page to capture specific Present Danger Threats. A required text field will be added on the Narrative tab for each identified threat. The same logic was added to the Allegation Narrative tab of the Access Report page to capture specific Impending Danger Threats. Based on the selection of present or impending danger threats, the Response Time field was modified to pre-fill according to the standards.

When a Supervisor is approving the Access Report, the Explain field on the Decision tab will be required when the Supervisor changes screening information.

The response time values of "within 24 hours" and "within 48 hours" were modified according to the standards to read "within 24-48 hours." This will be modified on the template and the report as well.

- (26426) Added a 'Notice to Tribal Agent' template under the Options drop-down on the Access Report page. This is for access workers and supervisors to use to inform tribal agents of a new CPS report on a tribal child.

Approvals

- (10323) A 'View By' group box was added to the Reroute Worker Approval page. The 'View By' group box contains radio buttons for 'County/State', 'Employing Entity', 'My County', 'Site/Office', and 'Workers for Supervisor', however it will default to 'My County.' This will prevent the worker from having to search out his or her county before rerouting their approval.

- Assessment**
 - (23591) This enhancement gives users the ability to create, edit, and view the Mandated Reporter template from the CW/JJ Assessment and the Child Welfare Report before and after approval and as many times as necessary.

- Assets and Income**
 - (25738) Changes have been made to the Assets and Employment page. The page is now called Assets and Income and can be accessed via the outliner or via the Basic tab on Person Management. These records will now be person specific instead of case specific. In addition, a SSI History tab has been added to the page to document SSI information.

- Checks and Payments Maintenance**
 - (26737) This Financial enhancement affects anyone who views or works with financial data through the Checks and Payments Maintenance page. In an effort to bring more flexibility to the way a user can search for financial data, a Person ID field has been added to the Checks and Payments Maintenance page. This will allow users to narrow their search results on this page by a specific Person ID.

- Eligibility**
 - (25738) IV-E Eligibility will now be automated by eWiSACWIS. eWiSACWIS will now look to documentation in the system to determine the IV-E status. In doing so, changes have been made to Assets and Income, Out of Home Placement, and Person Management. *Please see the respective areas for additional information.*
 - (26466) The text in the Details flare beside the Med Stat Code field on the Medicaid Certification page has been modified. The text has been updated to include who should be certified for Medicaid in eWiSACWIS (now includes court ordered kinship) and which Med Stat Codes should be used when certifying children.

- eWReports**
 - (26103) This enhancement to eWReports' On Demand tab and the Maintain Security by User page sorts the list of reports by the "Topic" and then by report's short-name identifier. This will help authorizers of eWReports to more easily see what topics contain reports.

- Family Assessment**
 - (25795) On the Safety Assessment, Analysis and Plan page, Details hovers were added next to each of the 17 safety threats in the Safety Threats group box on the Safety Threats tab. This will benefit workers by explaining the policy definition of each threat just by hovering over the Details.

Out of Home Placements

- (26232) This enhancement will affect any user that works with or views Placements, Services, and/or Agreements and Notices. The change separates and reorganizes the display of these pieces of work on the outliner and searches. Each piece of work will now be located under their respective icon. Under the Placements icon and the Services icon the pieces of work will display separated by a header section indicating whether the Placement or Service is "Pending," "Open," or "Closed." This will help users easily find and locate the piece of work that they are looking for.
- (25738) In order to approve an Out of Home Placement, at least one parent or legal guardian must be documented on the Parent Info tab of the child's Person Management page. This change was made to assist IV-E eligibility as well as the KIDS referral.

Upon approval of the initial Out of Home Placement for an episode (removal from home), the IV-E referral is automatically sent to the eligibility unit. Counties no longer need to "Refer to SEU Regional Manager" via the Eligibility page.

- (26374) This Placement change will affect anyone documenting a Respite Service. Users will no longer be able to document Respite as an Out of Home Placement. All Service Categories, Service Types, and Placement Setting referencing Respite will be inactivated for the Out of Home Placement page. However, users will be able to document Respite as a "service" from the Services page in either a paid or a non-paid structure.

Person Management

- (26735) The following changes have been made to the Health Concern page launched from Medical/Mental Health tab of Person Management:

When selecting Child Protective Exam/CPC Child Protective Exam, two new check boxes have been added to indicate if a medical follow up is recommended or a dental follow up is recommended.

When entering Comprehensive Mental Health Assessment as a Service type, a new checkbox has been added to capture if Treatment was recommended.

When selecting Well Child Exam/Visit as a type of service, a drop-down has been added indicating the Health Check Period. This drop-down will list all recommended times in which a child should receive a Well Child Exam/Visit. Also, when hovering over the Health Check Period, a Details flare will define Wisconsin's Early Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment Program (EPSDT).

When Mental/Behavioral Health Screen is selected as a type of service, a checkbox has been added to indicate if a MH assessment has been recommended.

- (25738) The U.S. Citizen check box has been replaced with a U.S. Citizen Status drop-down. In addition, a Citizenship Verification field has been added to identify U.S. citizenship. These changes were made to assist the IV-E Eligibility determination.

An Identity drop-down has been added to the Basic tab. Identity is documentation to prove you are who you are (via a driver's license, school ID card, passport, etc.) and will affect eligibility for BadgerCare Plus.

Access to the Assets and Income page has been added to the Options drop-down on the Basic tab.

The background check section on the Additional tab has been enhanced to allow the actual background check to be added to a person's record. The Adam Walsh/FBI, DOJ, and IBIS checks will be required for IV-E claiming. This will be used primary for home providers to assist in the IV-E eligibility determination.

Planning

- (23064) This enhancement is to modify the outliner and search views (in both case and participant views) to display the type and method of Permanency Plan Review or Hearing. This will aid workers in determining from their desktop whether the permanency plan review was a hearing or a review, and what type of review it was.

System wide

- (25738) A new avenue to add scanned legal documents, scanned provider background checks, as well as assets and income information has been added to the Utilities menu. This new avenue will allow scanned legal documents, scanned background checks, and assets and income information to be added to closed cases and provider records. This new functionality no longer requires users to have an assignment to a case or provider to add this information. The respective avenues can be accessed via Utilities > Background Check Search, Utilities > Legal Document Search, and Utilities> Maintain Assets and Income.

Trust Accounts

- (26736) This Trust Account enhancement affects anyone who views or works with Trust Accounts. In an effort to bring more flexibility to the way a user can search for Trust Accounts, a Person ID field has been added to the Trust Accounts Maintenance page. This will allow workers to narrow a search by County and Person ID.

Worker Assignment

- (24520) Enhancement to the Assignment Management page that disables the 'select' checkbox for reassigning an assignment when a worker is part of a pending approval chain.
