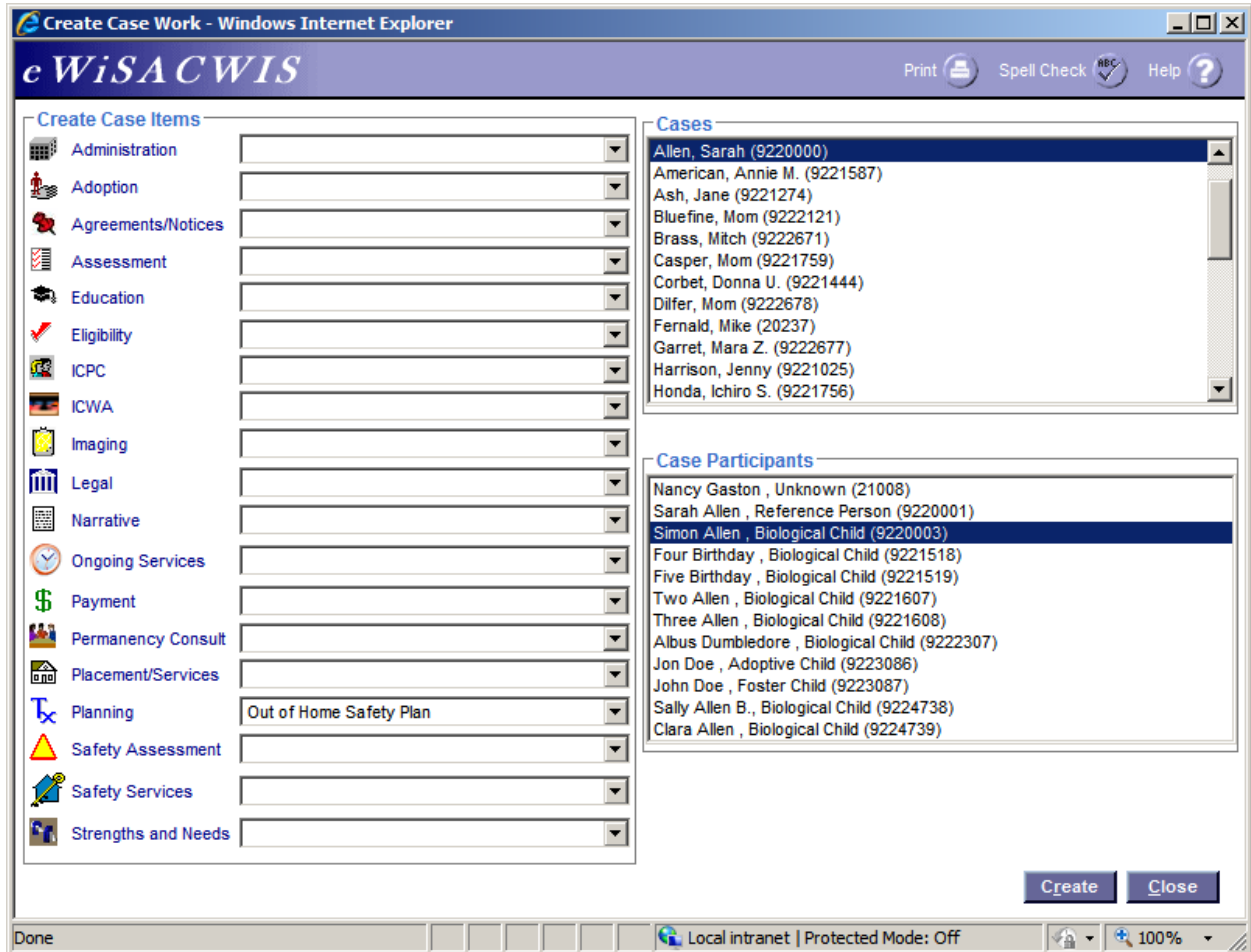


Out of Home Safety Plan

1. The Out of Home Safety Plan is accessed through Create > Case Work > Planning > Out of Home Safety Plan. Select the family and the case participant. Then click Create. This will open the Out of Home Safety and Planning page.



- The first tab is the OHSP Jurisdiction tab. Answer the two questions in the Jurisdiction group box regarding court order placement and voluntary placement.

The second group box is the Placement Conditions. This describes the type of placement which would best suit the child's needs. Select all that apply.

Evaluating Safety in Unlicensed and Licensed Home when placing a child in Out-of-Home Care as part of either a protective plan or an Out-of-Home safety plan. Provide information related to the assessment and evaluation of the safety of the placement.

For six month re-assessment of the safety of placement provide information and justification related to confirmation of the continuing suitability of the providers, absence of safety threats, the presence of indicators that the environment is safe and the child's adjustment to the placement.
