Re: Foster Care Rate Setting Reevaluation Results Notification for [Redacted]

This letter is a follow up to your rate reevaluation that occurred on [Redacted], regarding your Foster Care Reimbursement Rate. After completing your reevaluation it has been determined that you will receive a reimbursement rate of \$ [Redacted] per month for [Redacted], which goes into effect [Redacted].
