At a Glance

BMCW activity July 1 through September 30, 2006 as of September 30, 2006:*

- 8,444** Calls received by Intake 220-SAFE (YTD: 25,337)
- 117** Family cases transferred to Ongoing Case Management (YTD: 387)
- 173** Family cases transferred to in-home Safety Services (YTD: 532)
- 26** Families referred to Family Intervention Support and Services (FISS) (YTD: 150)

Permanency achieved: 316 children achieved permanency in the 3rd quarter

As of September 30, 2006:

- 176** Children reunified (YTD: 563)
- 43** Transfer of guardianship (YTD: 116)
- 83** Children adopted (YTD: 242)
- 14** Subsidized Guardianship Program (YTD: 142)

3rd quarter highlights:

- 145 more families were referred to Safety Services than were referred to Ongoing Case Management.
- 1,062 children achieved permanency year-to-date.
- In the 3rd quarter of 2006 the number of children in an out-of-home care placement decreased by 218 (8%) children.

During September 2006 there were:

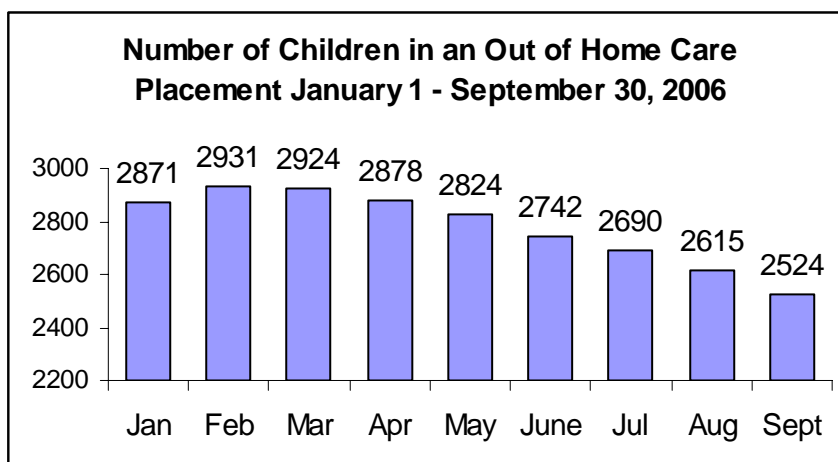
2, 524 Children in Out-of-Home Care Placement

- 261** (10.3%) Children in a relative licensed foster home
- 758** (30.%) Children with relatives on a CHIPS court order (non- licensed relatives Kinship Care providers)
- 853** (33.8%) Children in a non-relative licensed foster home
- 30** (1.2%) Children in a pre-adoptive home (licensed foster home)
- 307** (12.2%) Children in a treatment foster home
- 61** (2.4%) Children who have run away (AWOL)
- 106** (4.2%) Children in a group home
- 5** (0.2%) Children held in detention center
- 3** (0.1%) Children hospitalized
- 14** (0.6%) Children in a youth correctional facility
- 53** (2.1%) Children in a residential care center
- 21** (0.8%) Children in an assessment foster home for children under 12 years old
- 52** (2.1%) Children in an adolescent assessment or placement stabilization center

3,764 Children with relatives not involved with BMCW receiving Kinship Care subsidies

- 633** Children at home under the court's jurisdiction on a court order of supervision
- 735** Active foster homes

In the 3rd quarter of 2006 the number of children in an out-of-home care placement decreased by 218 (8%) children. Since January 1, 2006, there has been a 347(12%) decrease in the number of children in an out-of-home care placement.
