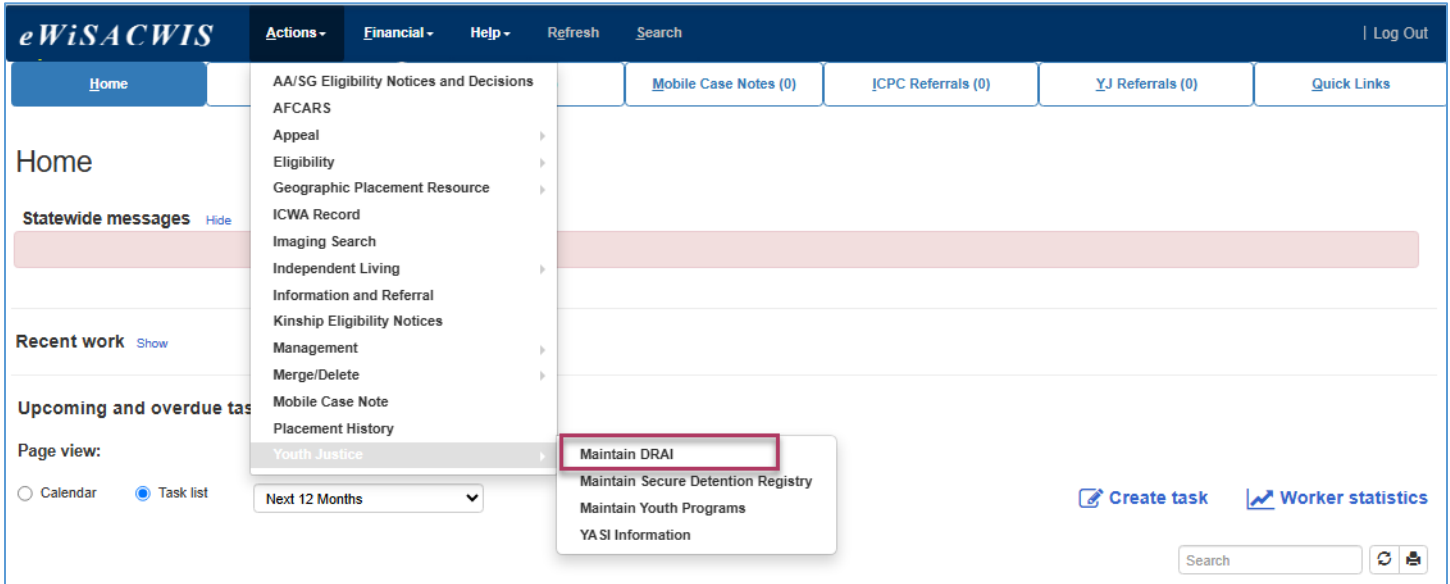


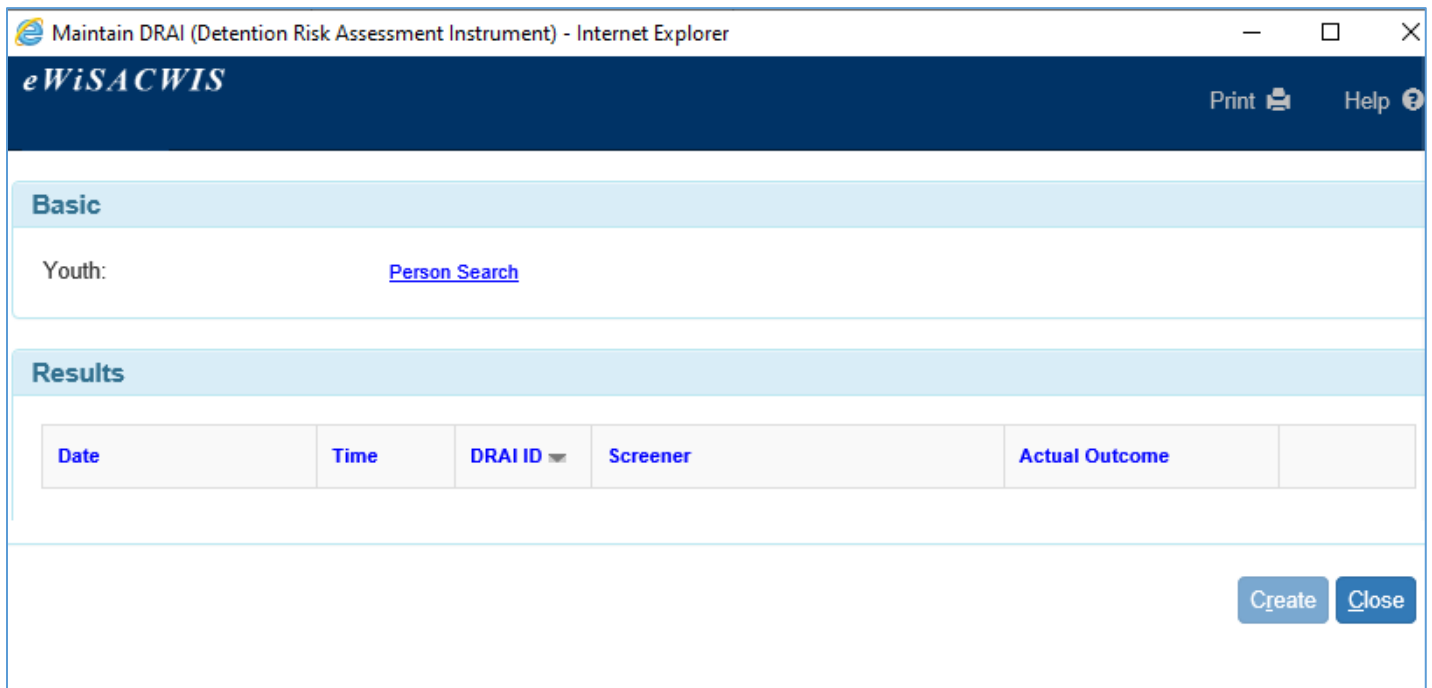
Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI)

Used for short-term decision-making, the DRAI is a fair and impartial screening of youth that are referred. Additional Security is needed to access the Maintain DRAI page

1. From the desktop's menu, select Actions> Youth Justice> Maintain DRAI to launch the page.



2. Click the [Person Search](#) hyperlink to select the youth being referred.



3. On the Person Search page, fill in at least the Last Name OR Person ID to complete and click Search.
 - First Name, SSN, DOB, Gender, Street, City, Zip Code, Incl. AKA, and Search Precision can be used to help reduce the amount of results the show in the Persons Returned section.

8. If there are any existing DRAI(s) for the youth, the Results section will display the Date, Time, DRAI ID, Screener, Actual Outcome, and a [View](#) or [Edit](#) hyperlink. This section displays in order with the most recent DRAI on the top. All columns are sortable by clicking on the heading name.

- If the [View](#) hyperlink is displayed in the last column, the DRAI has had the Completed checkbox checked and the DRAI is frozen but can be reviewed in read only.

- If the [Edit](#) hyperlink is displayed in the last column, the DRAI needs to be completed and will open in edit mode.

Note: if a DRAI is not completed (the Completed checkbox hasn't been checked), but is created and saved, a task will be created on the desktop of the screener until the DRAI is complete. The Due date will be 24 hours from creation.

9. Click Create to create a new DRAI or click the [Edit](#) or [View](#) hyperlinks to view/edit an existing one.

Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI) page

The Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI) page is modeled after the DRAI form DCF-F-5481-E and replaces filling out the paper form. A paper or electronic version of the DRAI created, can be generated from the page and will be pre-filled with all the information entered on the page at any given time.

1. On the Maintain DRAI (Detention Risk Assessment Instrument) page, in the Basic section, the selected Youth Name and Person ID will display as a hyperlink. Click the hyperlink to open Person Management in edit mode to update the youth's information as needed.
2. Date and Time of Intake is pre-filled when the DRAI is created but is editable if necessary.
3. A newly created Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI) page will pre-fill the Youth Information section with the Youth, DOB, Gender, Race, Ethnicity, Date and Time of Intake, County of Residence.
4. The Youth# is optional.
5. The Screener is pre-filled with the worker entering the DRAI.
 - a. Click the [Search](#) hyperlink to update the screener listed on the DRAI.
6. **Reason for Detention Request determines the page requirements and should be the first selection made before saving the page.**
7. The Referral Offense(s) section is used to enter the offenses listed at the time of the referral. Offenses are only required when Reason for Detention Request is "New Charges".
 - a. Offense Date is the date the offense occurred.
 - b. Counts are the number of counts for each offense.
 - c. Statute/Description/Classification will pre-fill when the 3 characters or numbers are entered from an offense identified.
 - d. Modifier(s) and Enhancer(s) [Select](#) hyperlink is used to identify modifiers or enhancers to an offense. A page will launch to check the appropriate identifiers.
 - e. Most Serious Alleged Offense? identifies the most serious offense for the referral.
 - i. Offense Date, Counts, Statute/Description/Classification, and Most Serious Alleged Offense? are required to complete the DRAI.

Note: Once a checkbox has been checked for an offense row, B1, will auto populate with the category of the most serious alleged offense row. This can be edited. The details hyperlink will display a list of categories and points associated with each offense.

- f. The [Delete](#) hyperlink will delete any row entered.
 - i. Clicking this hyperlink will generate a pop up asking, "Are you sure you want to delete this Offense?".
 1. Click Yes to delete the row or click No to return to the unchanged page.
- g. The Insert button will add as many offense rows are needed.

Note: Two offense lines are already inserted into the page on creation. If the second line isn't needed, it will need to be deleted prior to completing the form. If Reason for Detention Request is "New Charges", at least one Offense row is required.

These hyperlinks will open the pages in view only. If any updates are needed, the updates should be done from the hyperlinks to the page on the Case or YJ Referral tab.

9. The Scoring section is used to score the most serious alleged offense. Once checked in the above section, the Statue/Description/Classification value is displayed in B1.
10. B1-B5
 - a. Select the appropriate value for the youth. Like the paper form, each value has a corresponding score. Each question's score will calculate on the right side of the section and add or subtract from the Total Score. This score is used to determine the Initial Outcome value.
11. B1 has a Details hover that displays what each category is scored at and which offenses correspond with it.
12. B5: Aggravating Factors add 1 point for each check selection.
13. B5: Mitigating Factors remove 1 point for each check selection.

Note: It's possible to have a negative value in the B5 Score: field. Total Score: will calculate based on the selections made in B1 – B5.

14. B6: Initial Outcome will display the result of Total Score in the Scoring section. Possible values are:
- Released (Score 0 to 9)
 - Alternative (Score 10 to 16)
 - Detained (Score 17 and up)

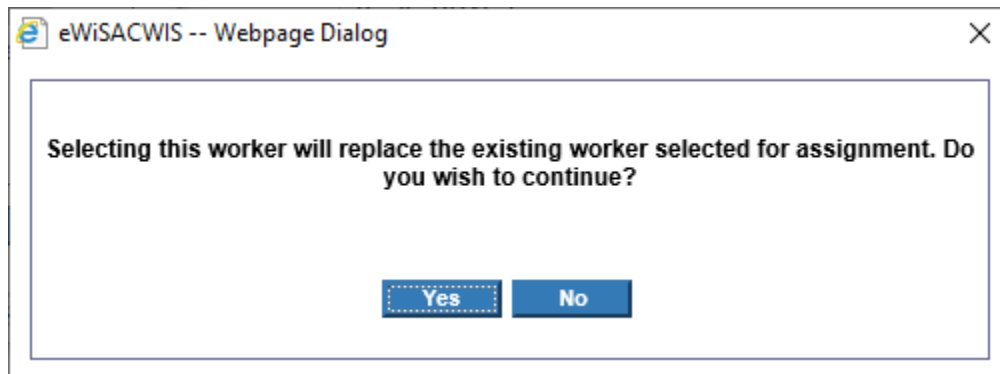
Once the DRAI is complete the created YJ Referral and (if created) the JS DR can be located from the desktop of the screener. The pending YJ Referral can be located in the YJ Referral tab of the desktop. The JS DR can be located from the Actions menu drop-down and selecting Maintain Secure Detention Registry.



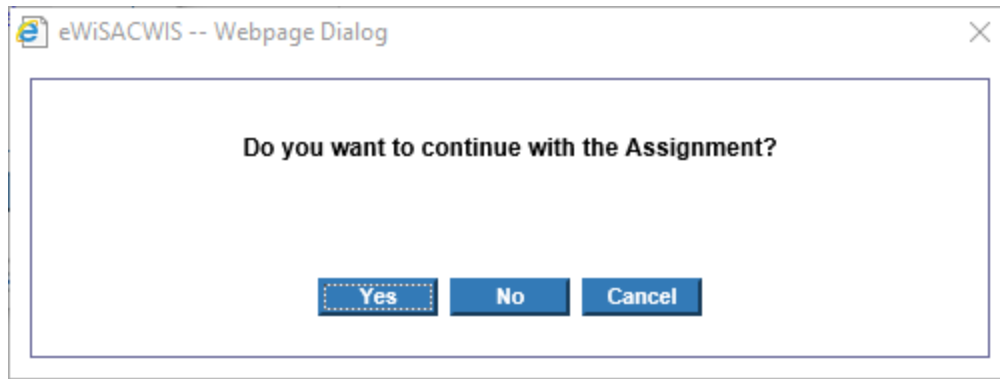
1. From the Desktop, to open the created YJ Referral click on the corresponding [Referral Number](#) in the Referral ID column. The referral can also be reassigned by clicking [Reassign](#) in the Actions column.



2. To reassign, click the [Select](#) hyperlink on the name of the worker. Use the View By section to view workers by County/State, My County, Employing Entity, Site/Office, or Workers for a Supervisor.
 - a. A pop up message will display confirming that the assignment should be change and prefills the remainder of the fields.



3. Click the Yes button to continue with the selection or click the No button to return to the Create Worker Assignment page.
 - a. Once Yes is selected, click the Assign button to continue with the reassignment and return the YJ Referral tab.
 - b. Clicking Close will launch a pop up message.



4. Click the Yes button to return to complete the reassignment and return to the YJ Referral tab, click the No button to close the Create Worker Assignment page and return to the YJ Referral tab, or click Cancel button to return to the Create Worker Assignment page.

YJ Referral

Only Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI) pages that have a Reason for Detention Request of “New Charges” and have the Completed checkbox checked upon save will generate a YJ Referral. When created, the YJ referral will pre-fill the information from the Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI) page including all the information in the Referral Information section. The Youth will also be added a YJ Referral Participant on the Participants tab with the Relationship of Reference Person and having the Roles of IY-RN (Identified Youth and Report Name). These pre-fills can be modified or added to as needed to complete the referral. The Referral Offense(s) section is also pre-filled from the Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI) page but can also be modified. See the [YJ Referral](#) user guide on the Knowledge Web for more information on completing a YJ Referral. If a YJ Referral is created in error, it can be marked as such on the YJ Referral tab.

1. From the Desktop, click the YJ Referrals tab
2. Search or locate the Referral that was created in error.
3. Those with security, will be able to check the box to remove the referral.
 - a. Clicking Yes to the pop up Confirmation message will permanently remove the YJ Referral and delink it from any other pieces of work such as the DRAI, JS DR, and remove it from the Recent Work section of the Home tab.
 - b. Clicking No will return to the YJ referral tab with no changes.

Note: A YJ Referral cannot be marked Made In Error once it has been linked to a Case, however a YJ Referral can be delinked from a Youth Justice Case Information page and a Case if appropriate. After it has been delinked the YJ Referral will display on the YJ Referrals tab where it can be marked Made In Error.
