

TANF SERVICES FUNDED IN WISCONSIN

FAMILY RESOURCE CENTER SERVICES

Program Description:

The Children's Trust Fund utilizes TANF dollars to support 17 Family Resource Centers around the state. Recognizing that all parents need help at some time, but that not all families need the same kind or intensity of support, Family Resource Centers have developed a wide range of services to meet the individual needs of community. The services include parent education and fatherhood programs.

Client Group Served:

Family Resource Centers primarily focus on parents and their children from birth to age three. The Centers will use TANF funding to provide services for families up to 200 percent of the poverty level including: parenting skills training; programs and local media campaigns to promote responsible fatherhood and increase the capacity for fathers to support their children emotionally; and activities to promote parental access and visitation.

Critical Indicators:

The total number of clients/families served in SFY2000 is 5,200.
