

## TANF SERVICES FUNDED IN WISCONSIN

### IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM

#### Program Description:

The Immunization Program provides TANF funds to local health departments, federally qualified community health centers and WIC clinics for outreach and education activities and to track preschool children to insure that they stay on schedule for recommended immunizations through reminder/recall notices which are sent to parents. The tracking/recall notices inform parents that their child is either due for an immunization or is behind schedule. Agencies work cooperatively with private providers to promote the medical home concept for all health care visits. Funds from the National Immunization Program at the CDC pay for infrastructure costs including immunization clinics at times accessible to working parents such as evenings and weekends.

#### Client Group Served:

TANF eligible children and families.

#### Critical Indicators:

In SFY 2000 the Immunization Program distributed 400,096 doses of vaccine to these agencies with a dollar value of \$4,535,100.
