1	Chippewa Valley	Post-secondary	Welding Career Opportunities	\$34,000	Develop a 16 week welding certificate program that incorporates team teaching with an Adult Basic Education Instructor 50% of the time to enhance the technical education. The courses in the certificate program will be fully transferable into the welding technical diploma program.
2	Lakeshore	Bridge	Three Courses Closer to College (Mfg)	\$34,000	Develop contextualized bridge curricula that will assist GOAL (Goal Oriented Adult Learning) students transition to career pathways in the manufacturing industry with emphasis on key occupations with shared math and related reading competencies: Industrial Maintenance, Machine Tool Operation, and Welding.
3	Moraine Park, Gateway & Milwaukee	Both	Industrial Maintenance Career Ladder	\$70,751	Create a career ladder for the Industrial Maintenance program with three to five certificates embedded in the program.
4	Moraine Park, Gateway & Milwaukee	Both	Welding – A Bridging Project	\$34,000	Create a career pathway using an integrated Adult Basic skills and/or English Language Learning (ELL) and Occupational team teaching model.
5	Northcentral	Bridge	ELL Nursing Assistant Bridge	\$17,419	Integrate English Language Learning (ELL) instruction into the federally mandated nursing assistant curriculum, while maintaining industry skill standards and state licensing requirements.
6	Northeast	Bridge	Rising in Northeast WI (mfg & welding)	\$33,633	Develop two certificate programs, General Manufacturing and Welding, which equip learners with the basic skills to secure a job and pursue additional training/educational opportunities for increasing earnings by establishing an integrated, contextualized curriculum.
