2.	Yes	Combine Geographic Areas within an Agency's Current Contracts	Agency A has earned RFS for two contracts. One contract is for a consortium with geographic areas 1, 2, and 3. The second contract is for geographic area 4. Agency A plans to combine the geographic areas covered by the two contracts. Agency A does not plan to add or subtract geographic areas beyond 1-4.	√  For all geographic areas		1-5  Complete questions 1-5 only
3.	Yes	Change by Adding Other RFS Agency	Agency A and B have earned RFS. The two agencies decide to become a consortium. Agencies will decide who will be the lead agency. The lead agency will submit a RFS plan.	√		1-5
4.	Yes	Add Non-RFS Area	Agency A earned RFS for geographic areas 1 and 2. Agency A wants to add a new geographic area 3 that did not meet RFS. Agency A should complete a RFS Plan for areas 1 and 2 in order to retain RFS in case the proposal does not result in a contract. Form 1B is not required with the RFS Plan.
