## Sesquipedalian Obscurantism

**Sesquipedalian** *n.* One who is inordinately infatuated with polysyllabic obfuscation, preferring never to employ a less complicated syntactic arrangement of descriptive words when there exists a single expressive unit that amalgamates the multiplicity of morphemes<sup>1</sup> comprising the simpler phrase. Among the manifold objectives of multisyllabic, holophrastic<sup>2</sup> verbalism are those of: rendering the author's meaning indisputably precise yet simultaneously incomprehensible; demonstrating through superior orthography and lexical awareness that the writer is manifestly more erudite than the reader; disempowering intellectual challenge to the proponent's argument by using logomachinations<sup>3</sup> to divert discussion to the establishment of the opponent's comprehension of the vocabulary as opposed to addressing the factual import of the treatise which, upon analysis, may well prove amphigorous<sup>4</sup>. The obscurantist<sup>5</sup> sesquipedalian is likely to compound the reader's difficulties by indulging in glossosynthesis<sup>6</sup>, thus enabling the author to dismiss all opposing views as ultracrepidarios<sup>7</sup>. In other words, a sesquipedalian is one who would call a shovel a manuo-pedal excavatory implement<sup>8</sup>. *Case Visual Metaphor = Desktop*

## 20833\*\* - Foster Care/Out of Home Placements

The purpose of this report is to identify cases that have errors regarding out-of-home placements to aid future data clean up effort. The focus of the report will be children with valid AFCARS placements.

The report will review placement history for children across multiple cases and identify the following placement errors where applicable:

Placement Gap Error – one or more gaps within a placement episode

Discharge Error – a placement that ends without a discharge and a new placement has not been recorded; or placement episodes exist where there are two consecutive removals without a discharge in between the two removal dates

Removal Error – a placement episode where the removal date has not been identified or placement episodes where there are two consecutive discharges without a removal in between the two discharge dates

Potential Discharge Error – a discharge with a new placement episode beginning with a removal within 7 days of the previous discharge. (continued)

## 20833\*\* - Foster Care/Out of Home Placements (continued)

- The report will contain one row per child per case with an indication of the error type(s) found. Children will be included in the report only if an error was detected.
- The report can be run for all counties or a single county for a specified query period start date and end date. All placements open at any time within the query period will be included in this report.
- This report will run monthly and posted to the eWReports homepage and also be available to users on an as requested (on demand) basis.

## **852\*\* and 6495 - Worker Assignment – JM**

852 – The system will provide the ability to create all assignments to a case at one time. For example when creating primary and secondary assignments to the same case, these assignments can be completed in one transaction .

6495 - The Workers for Supervisor view will be modified to include the worker that launched the page and all the workers that particular worker supervises. This display will allow for easier selection when a worker or supervisor is doing a self-assignment. This is the default view that displays when the page is launched.

## 20849\*\* - SM10a20 Report – Time to Adoption

This enhancement will allow the SM10A to run for a County and All sites as well as running for the county State and for a complete adoption region.

One county and all sites. Adoptions run per region.

The changes to the report that were made included moving all columns starting with adoption type through the end of the detail spreadsheet to the front part of the spreadsheet right after the adoption site/location column.

Code was added to calculate a new column of data for the summary report to reflect the average number of days from removal to TPR broken out by time to adoption range with the average across all time period listed in the total row.

## **20913\*\* - Search**

The new View Not Approved/Cancelled checkbox on the desktop for release 2.5 has been added to both case and provider search pages.

## **21316\*\* - Person Management**

The Quality Service Review Protocol template is now available in eWiSACWIS. This template is child specific and is launched from the Create Case Work page under Administration.

## **21368\*\* - Document Plans**

The Judicial Determination tab of Perm Plan Review/Hearing page was designed based on the JD-1791 form. In August 2006, the JD-1791 form was updated. This enhancement synchronizes the pages in eWiSACWIS with the form. The template has not been added to the application.

## **7282\*\* - Maintain Case**

This enhancement adds the case ID to the Create Case Work and Create Provider Work pages.

















Also adds the case participants Person ID next to their name under the Case Participants group box on the Create Case work window.

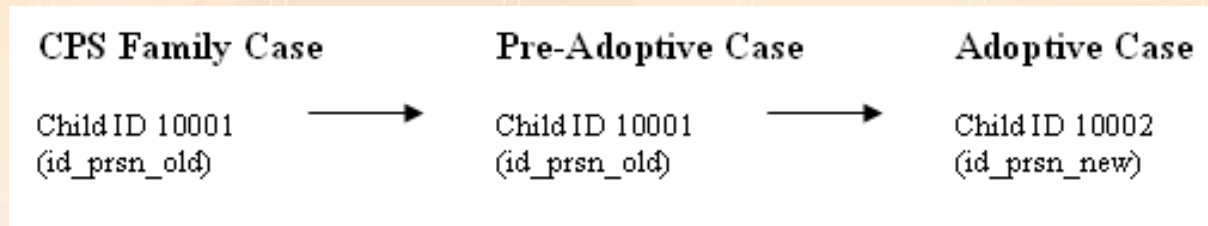

## 20434\* - Person Management - JM

Potential Duplicate person displays pre-adoptive names in Case Maintenance for children who are adopted. The logic for displaying the potential duplicate person will be modified to make sure that the match displayed is not either of the id\_prsn records on the adoption match table. The system will check both id\_prsn\_old and id\_prsn\_new and if \*either\* is a potential duplicate match, the record will not display online. This processing will also apply to inserting participants on an Access Report or Case.



## **20827\* - Manage Worker**

A new report, CM1801 Worker Training, will be delivered to eWReports on a quarterly basis and available on an on demand request basis.

This report will be based on the information completed on the eWiSACWIS worker record.

## **AFCARS Federal Review Modifications**

### **21134\* - AFCARS**

Added code in preprocess save to compare the child date of birth with caretaker(s) date of birth. Display an error if the caretaker(s) is younger than the child.

### **21139\* - AFCARS**

Added code to display an error message if the age of caretakers is less than 18 or Greater than 75.

### **21140\* - AFCARS**

Added code to check for Home Provider Parent 1 and Parent 2 Age. Display an error message if the age is below 18 years

## **21145\* - AFCARS (More)**

Modify the Mother Married at Child's Birth field and Father Married at Child's Birth field on the Adoption Referral page to be read-only fields that pre-fill from the fields on Person Management. The values selected on the Person Management page will pre-fill on the Adoption Referral page.

## **21135\* - AFCARS (Even More)**

The Removal Reason pop up window off of the Out-of-Home Placement window and the Correction Removal Reason off of the Placement Correction window have been modified so Parent's/Parent(s) now displays as Caretaker's/Caretaker(s).

Underreporting of data in this area has prompted this enhancement.

## **21181\* - Access**

Added Screen Out - Non-Caregiver to the dropdown selections.

## 21252\* - Merge Person

The purpose of this enhancement is to modify the duplicate person logic so that duplicate people are not identified as a potential duplication based on a name match only.

Additionally, this enhancement includes adding new processing to the person merge batch to record all the information necessary for a reversal of the merge if a merge is completed in error and needs to be undone.

## 21419\* - Case Visual Metaphor (i.e. Desktop)

The following changes will be made to the desktop display of Narratives:

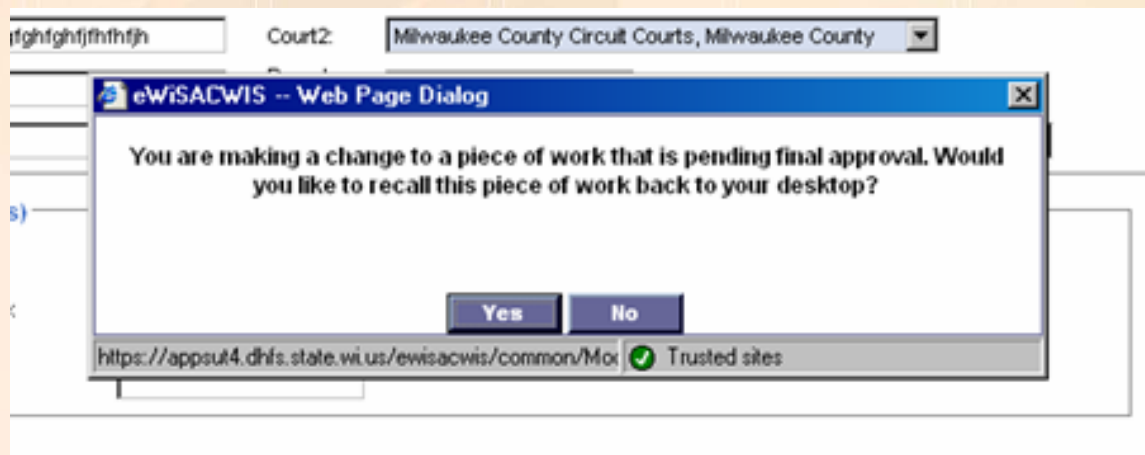
1. Change the Case Notes hyperlink to display Category - Type as the hyperlink. This will make the case notes display consistent with the provider notes display. This change will be applied to both Case and Participant views.
2. The word (Details) will be added to the right of the Category - Type. A screen tip will be added that displays the first 120 characters of the case note text when the worker hovers over (Details). The text can wrap to display the text on 2 lines. This change will be applied to both Case and Participant views.
3. Add the case participants identified in the case note to the desktop display. Names will display in ( ) and will be separated by a ";". This change will be applied to the case view only.
4. The changes outlined above will also apply to the Narrative, Assessment, and Access subject areas as these areas display case or provider notes.
5. The changes outlined above apply to the Desktop (Cases and Providers expandos), cases and providers accessed from the Workers expando, and to the Utility Search.

## 6930\* - Assignment New Recall Functionality

This enhancement will display a pop-up message indicating the piece of work is going to be recalled to alert a worker when a change is made that results in a piece of work being recalled.

Additionally, this change will recall the approval to the worker making the change to the piece of work.

If a supervisor assigned to the case, that has the approval, makes an update to the piece of work then the update will be allowed with no auto-recall. The supervisor will still have the ability to manually recall/reroute the piece of work through the standard recall/reroute processing.



## **8114\* - Home Provider**

The enhancement modifies (home inquiry, home provider, private provider, create provider address, maintain provider address) pages to add a field to capture and display an E-Mail address.

## **8161\* - AFCARS (still more)**

For all new person records created in the system, the Child Previously Adopted field on the Additional tab of the Person Management window will default to the new reference value of 'Not Determined.'

Not Determined will be noted as an AFCARS error for element #16 on the AFCARS window.

It is important to verify this information and complete the field appropriately.

## **8333\* - Medical**

The Medical/Mental Health Profile will be listed at all times on the outliner (as well as case and person search) regardless of the Date Restricted checkbox selection from the outliner.

## **9481\* - Foster Care/Out of Home Placements**

Currently, the Service Category and the Service Type on the OHP and the In Home Service pages are disabled as soon as the worker saves the page.

This enhancement will allow workers to edit the OHP and the In Home Service pages until the placement is approved by the supervisor.

## **9801\* - Home Provider**

This enhancement will add the Duplicate Person Icon (i.e. Potential Duplicate Person functionality) to the Provider Members tab.

## **4578 - Case Visual Metaphor (i.e. Desktop)**

The placement status now displays correctly based on the status of the placement (Pending, Approved, Not Approved, Pending Closure, Closed).

When the status is either pending closure or closed, the closing reason is displayed.

Similarly, the status of the FCRS is displayed as Pending, Approved, Not Approved, Pending Closure, Closed.

When the status is either pending closure or closed, the closing reason is displayed.



## **6256 - Case Visual Metaphor (i.e. Desktop)**

The service type is now displayed on the outliner next to the placement type.

The name of the child prefills in the following format: Last Name, First Name MI.

The enhancement also increases the indent for the FCRS to more easily discern this row of data.

## **6898 - Activity Notes**

The print out for provider notes now displays the Provider Name and Provider ID labels.



## 7360 – Search

Reference data values were showing up as duplicate values in the Type field on the Provider Organization tab of the Search page.

The values now display as follows:

## **20511 - Foster Care/Out of Home Placements**

The Info. to Foster Parent Part A (CFS-872A) template has been modified to include a line on the cover sheet that includes "RE: <Enter Child's Name Here>".

## **21000 - Foster Care/Out of Home Placements**

Copy over fixes:

The provider name is correctly displayed on the FCRS page.

The template will no longer display the name of the previous provider.

The narrative fields on the tabs will prefill correctly.

## **21221 – Access**

If "Relative/Court Ordered Care provider" is chosen as the "AM Relationship to victim" on the Allegation tab, the PS report type will now default to primary caregiver. It had been defaulting as secondary/non-caregiver.

### **21236 - System Wide**

eWiSACWIS needs to be compatible with Internet Explorer 7, which is due for release 4th quarter 2006 and will be part of the new Windows Vista operating system that will be widely available starting Jan. 2007.

### **21238 – eWReports**

eWReports and Change Request Tracker need to be compatible with Internet Explorer 7, which is due for release 4th quarter 2006 and will be part of the new Windows Vista operating system that will be widely available starting Jan. 2007.

### **21237 – ePass**

ePASS needs to be compatible with Internet Explorer 7, which is due for release 4th quarter 2006 and will be part of the new Windows Vista operating system that will be widely available starting Jan. 2007.

## **21261 - Activity Notes**

When a worker's desktop is set to an 800x600 resolution, the Options dropdown field on the Provider Notes Criteria Search results window is now viewable and accessible to print all notes.

## **21262 – Assessment**

The description link will no longer remain enabled after approving the Assessment.



## 21373 – Assessment

This enhancement resolves the problem when a user copies over a safety assessment and changes of the safety assessment questions that had been answered 'Yes' to 'No'.

When this is done, all of the descriptions and services should be removed from the Description of Safety Threats tab. This was not happening.

Similarly, in the Services Available/Accessible group box, if any of the radio buttons were selected, the radio buttons should now be blank. This was not happening.

Lastly, the "All Needed Services/activities provided" radio button remained selected.

## **21380 – Search**

Assignments are now displayed under restricted cases when a restricted case is searched by a worker who doesn't have security to view information for restricted cases.

## **21386 - Foster Care/Out of Home Placements**

Placement History Correction page fix:

Two identical placements appear.

Yet, only one placement was recorded in the PHC page.

The outliner should have displayed only one placement.

This has been fixed.

## **21390 - Home Provider License**

The date on the Foster Care Licensure Notification now displays the current system date as indicated on the template mapping document. Had been displaying the date of May 24 2004.

## 21391 - Activity Notes

If a worker enters correction notes and then selects the Create button to create a new case note, the correction notes are no longer being overwritten.

## **21400 - Private Provider and Placement History Correction**

On the Approval Management window, the system will no longer produce a Fatal Application Error when clicking on the Private Provider link or when clicking the checkbox and trying to approve the private provider.

## **Inactive service categories:**

**21411** - Payment request page no longer showing inactive service categories.

**21412** - Licensing page no longer showing inactive service categories.

**21413** - Provider services tab no longer showing inactive service categories.

**21437** - Provider retrieval page is no longer showing inactive service categories.

## 21394 – ICPC Record - New Reports

### Reports Changes / Tracking Requirements Needed:

1. The number of days between the date ICPC received the completed home study and the date ICPC either approves or denies the home study on all (open & closed) cases where WI is the receiving state.
2. The number of days between the date WI ICPC receives a home study request and the date of "provisional approval," along with the name of the sending state.
3. The number of requests for a home study extension and their reasons.
4. The number of extensions that led to an approval or denial within 15 days of the requested extension, as well as the number of extensions not completed within 15 days.

## 21327\*\* - ICPC

### A. Data Elements Requested to be Tracked Indefinitely:

1. Add a new date field to record the date ICPC receives the completed home study from the WI County/Agency. (The new federal law requires ICPC staff to approve or deny placement within 14 days of receipt of the completed home study.)

### B. Data Elements Requested to be Tracked at least until 2010:

1. Add a new date field entitled "Provisional Approval". (The new federal law provides "provisional" approval to home studies exempting education & training of prospective foster/adoptive parents in order to meet the 30 day timely home study incentive.)

### C. Data Elements Requested to be Tracked Until 9/30/2008:

1. Add a new date field entitled "Extension Requested". (The new federal law allows an additional 15 day extension to complete a home study if held up due to circumstances beyond the agencies control.)
2. Add a new field entitled "Extension Reason" for ICPC to document the circumstance leading to the request for an extension.

## **6634 – Eligibility**

The system correctly displays the latest Medicaid Certification approval status as Pending, Approved, Not Applicable and/or Needs State Approval.

## **20303 – Eligibility**

The system will now require the certification date and stat code on medicaid certification page.

The system will now check if DOB and Gender are missing on the medicaid eligibility determination page when insert button is clicked.

If missing, an error will be triggered.

## 20439\*\* – Eligibility

Federal claiming guidelines require State approval prior to beginning Title IV-E claiming.

The Adoption Eligibility module has been modified to accommodate State level sign-off and separate the Title IV-E funding determination from the child's adoption assistance eligibility information.

Adapt the foster care eligibility processing and system batches to fit with the new Adoption Funding Determination procedures.

Additionally, the Adoption Funding Re-determination has been modified to allow for a more robust and thorough Re-determination process.

Actual workflow had begun offline as of Sept 1<sup>st</sup>.
