eWiSACWIS Release 2.7

(March 27th 2007)

March - 6024

- Supervisors are now able to edit work that was sent to them for approval without needing to have an assignment to the case and without having to return the work to the worker.

March - 20515

- The AFCARS Tickler logic has been modified to prevent ticklers for children who are in an adult or youth correctional facility.
- The tickler production now resumes at the previously established timeline once a child returns to placement from these types of facilities.

March - 21271

- Counties now have the ability to modify distribution lists and even turn off certain messages that they do not find beneficial.
- Check Disposition, Emergency Protective Services Alert - Assessment Supervisor, Imaging, Independent Investigation, Open Case - Screen In, Open Case - Screen Out, Provider - Access Report
- Counties can contact the helpdesk to request a modification.

March - 6617

- The date and time of screening decision is now a user entered field. The date cannot precede the actual date and time report received and cannot be a future date.

March - 21755

- Fixed an issue where the Permanency Plan tickler was not being generated.
- The tickler is now generated as expected upon approval of a removal out of home placement.

March - 20496

- Gives Eligibility specialists the ability to void a IV-E line without creating a new one.

March - 22124

- Copied MA records correctly display on the Adoptive case. The "No Rows Found" error no longer results when the MA record is expanded.

March - 21644

- Rate Settings now display "nested" under the placements.
- This includes all possible view scenarios (Search and Desktop views).
- Rate Settings used to display off the Case.

March - 21646

- In order to facilitate the clean-up of person records, the edit that currently prevents the merging of persons attached to an investigation, has been removed.

March - 21487

- Ongoing Model (FA & CP and the CPE) functionality has been added to eWiSACWIS Anywhere.

March - 10334

- Background Information Disclosure (HFS-64) is a requirement under the Wisconsin Caregiver Background Check Law: The acronym BID has been included as a 'type' under the Background Check tab, in the Person Management window.

March - 21697

- The sensitivity given to 'Medium' on the precision bar has been reduced to allow search to find more the names that are close to what was searched.

March - 21844

- For the Child Welfare Report, the worker field now prefills the name of the worker that created the document AND the supervisor field now prefills the name of the worker's supervisor. The name no longer changes to the worker who launched the document instead of the worker who created the document.

March - 21837

- The State developed imaging functionality in eWiSACWIS to support storing and categorizing of images such as participant photos and legal documents related to case and case participants.

- With passage of the 2006 federal deficit reduction act, changes were made to title IV-E policy related to claiming for foster care candidates. These changes included the following:
- Requiring re-determinations of candidacy status every six months rather than every twelve months (as documented in the case plan, court order or eligibility determination documentation).
- Requiring that the child be at “imminent risk” of placement, rather than “serious risk” of placement.

June 26th - 22718

- Modifies the SM05 Case Closure batch to allow reopened cases that were previously allowed to close (without Assessments for PS Reports) to close again without the assessment.

June 26th - 22410

The 'Explain' text field located under the Supervisor Decision group box on the Decision Tab of the Access Report page will become required when the supervisor has selected a screening decision different from the worker's screening recommendation.

- Old Case Progress Evaluations and Family Assessments are now displaying on the outliner as expected.

June 26th - 22632

- The TPR Batch will no longer copy CPEs and FACPs to Pre-adoptive Cases.

June 26th - 22537

- When a user copies over a Court Report from an existing one that was created by another worker, the name on the template will be updated to that of the worker copying over the Court Report.

June 26th - 22676

- The Access page will no longer generate a Fatal Application Error when a user checks the 'Incl. AKA' checkbox when searching for participants.

June 26th - 22421

- Assessment Contacts will now default the Face-to-Face Contact Type to N/A when the Type is Telephone Call.

June 26th – 22450, 22459

- After sending a CPE or FACP approval to a supervisor, any change to the CPE or FACP will recall the approval to the user IF the user indicates they wish for it to be returned.

June 26th - 22317

- If a worker changes their answer to 'Yes' (for the Parents Protect Children question) under the Plan Analysis tab and/or deletes the services they entered, the services on the template (along with the associated identified safety threats) will no longer incorrectly populate to the template.

June 26th - 22498

- The FACP and the CPE is now sorted correctly under the Ongoing Services icon on the outliner. The pending CPE will be displayed first.

June 26th - 22218

- Modifies the adoption batch to copy a child's Program Assignment from the pre-adoptive case to the adoptive case.
- Program Assignment is currently being used to track Subsidized Guardianship and W-2 Healthy Families related cases.

June 26th - 22620

- When the case closure batch determines a required discharge reason is missing, it looks up the most recent episode to list details in the case_closure_details table.
- If the most recent episode is not an out of home placement, the details listed (on the closure denial reasons expando) will now be correct.

June 26th - 22232

- Termination of an Out of Home Safety Plan no longer sets the previous historical plan to ongoing. This was preventing a case from closing.

June 26th - 22603

- A Case Progress Evaluation will no longer ask for a target end date when a goal status is updated to Achieved.

June 26th - 22753

- The Perm Plan template will now pre-fill the Date of Removal even if the date of removal (of the current episode) is in a case different than the one the Perm Plan is being created for.

June 26th - 22355

- The approval radio button will be blanked out (i.e. reset to no approval) when a user selects and then deselects the agreement concluded checkbox on the Adoption Assistance Agreement before saving.

June 26th - 7941

- On the Delinquency Assessment and Court Report, the father's address information now prefills correctly.
- The field was prefilling with the case address and not the father's address from the person management page.

June 26th - 10530

- My Ticklers: when a supervisor has base ticklers (their own work) for a case and at least one escalated tickler (from another worker), the desktop no longer shows all ticklers (base and escalated) as escalated ticklers.
- Escalated Ticklers: when a supervisor has escalated ticklers on their desktop for a case from TWO separate workers, the desktop no longer shows that all ticklers were escalated from the same worker.
