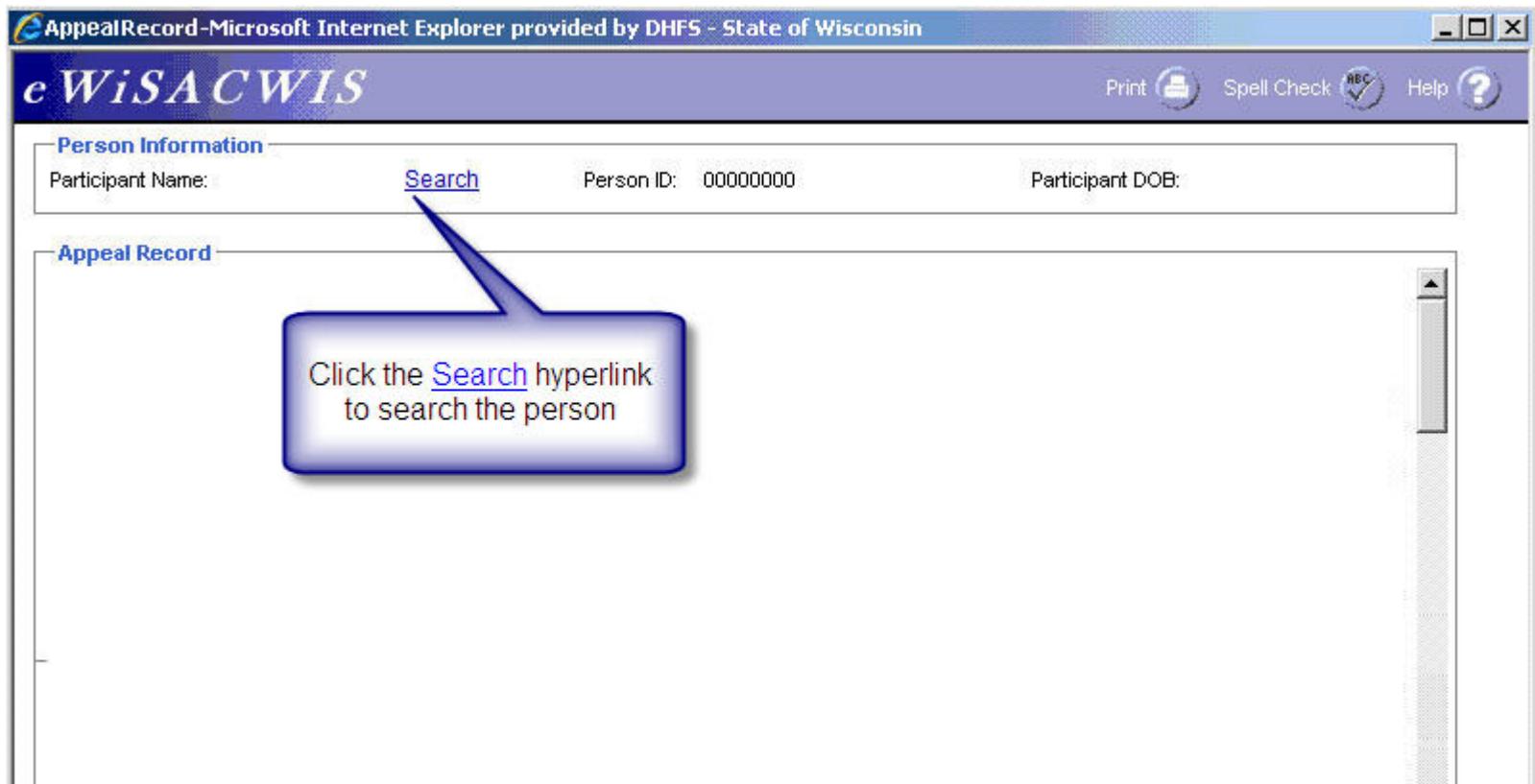

 - Accessed via Utilities > Maltreater Appeal
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
Appeals

Appeals - Summary

- There will be a visual indicator that an appeal record exists for this assessment on the outliner (still being designed)
 - The current approved decision will display on the outliner for that assessment as well. If all substantiated allegations were successfully appealed, then the Assessment will display Unsubstantiated.
 - Approved Appeal Records will have the option to be 'Voided' if they were created in error
