

eWiSACWIS Reports Update – March and June 2007 Releases

New and/or Updated Reports - The following reports are now available/or were put into production with the March 2007 release:

- **Foster Care AFCARS Report (CM2102)** – The reports was enhanced to add Provider Name and ID on the detail file when the error group = Provider.
- **NCANDS-** The Child File program was modified to add the new A/N Code 'Manufacturing Methamphetamine'.
- **Foster Parent Characteristics Report (PM02a08)** - The purpose of this report is to capture comprehensive information about active home providers and their corresponding licenses (where applicable) during the reporting period. The report was enhanced to include some new fields on the summary file, including a count of active providers and license status and capacity of providers.
- **CPS Timeliness Report (SM06a05)** – The report was enhanced to reflect the percent of Initial Assessments completed in 60 days from the CPS Report date.
- **Assessment Data Quality Report (SM06a06)** – The report detail was enhanced to add data regard any previously assigned worker with an Initial Assessment assignment type.
- **Placement Stability Report (SM10a25)** - The report was enhanced to properly count and display placement changes and settings.
- **Kinship Care Report (SM10a32)** – The report was modified to provide additional summary counts regarding child placement, payment and counts for a reporting period. In addition, a WORD summary output is generated with the report.

Reports Under Development- The following reports will be put into production with the June 2007 release:

- **Case List Report (SM04a02)** – This report is being correction to properly report the number of children in OHC in the detail or summary outputs.
- **AFSA Report (SM10a27)** – The summary report was modified to separate the 15-16 month grouping with the March 2007 Release. Additional development is underway to ensure the months in care per ASFA is being properly calculated and displayed for children subject to ASFA during the given reporting period.
