

eWiSACWIS Reports Update –June and September 2007 Releases

New and/or Updated Reports - The following reports are now available/or were put into production with the June and September releases:

- **Case List Report (SM04a02)** - The purpose of this report is to capture comprehensive cases open during a monthly period. The report was enhanced to correctly capture the number of children in who are in out-of-home care in these cases.
- **ASFA Documentation Report (SM10a27)** – The purpose of this report is to support county and BMCW efforts to monitor and achieve timely compliance with the Adoption and Safe Families Act (ASFA). The report was enhanced to properly calculate the total number of months a child was in placement by excluding time in those placement settings that are not subject to state or federal statutes. The report was also modified to separate the groups of children who are in care 15 of the last 22 months from the children who were in placement 16 of the last 22 months.
- **Initial Assessment Activity Report (SM06a04)** – The purpose of this report is to provide monthly statistics on the cases where an initial assessment was approved during a given month. The report summary and detail were enhanced to reflect the new initial assessment functionality designed to support both maltreatment and maltreater determinations.

Additional enhancements were made to

Reports Under Development- The following reports will be put into production with the December 2007 release:

- **Maltreatment Recurrence Report (SM06a03)** – The purpose of this report is to measure state and county performance on the federal outcome measure related to child safety. The report is being modified to properly capture performance related to maltreatment recurrence.
- **AFSA Report (SM10a27)** – Described above, this reports is being modified to accommodate the new ASFA page functionality to be issued with the December 2007 eWiSACWIS Release.
- **Placement Stability (SM10a25)** - The purpose of this report is to measure state and county performance on the federal permanency measure related to a child’s placement stability. The report is being enhanced to count a child’s placement settings in a manner consistent with corrections to the state’s AFCARS file.

Additional enhancements to the state’s NCANDS file, the AFCARS files, and the report used to create the Annual Child Abuse and Neglect Report to accommodate federal requirements and changes to the application.
