

## Wisconsin Women's Council & Wisconsin Crime Victims Council

### *Human Trafficking in Wisconsin: Building Resources for Hope Initiative June 2015 – February 2016 Project Analysis Overview*

**Initiative Goal:** Identify Wisconsin-based service providers for inclusion in the National Human Trafficking Resource Center (NHTRC) Hotline & identify local law enforcement contacts for inclusion in the NHTRC Law Enforcement Referral Protocol.

**Objective 1: Increase the number and quality of Wisconsin-based victim service resources in the NHTRC Resource Database.**

#### **Baseline (June 2015):**

*NHTRC Resource Database:* 63 Wisconsin-based resources included in the directory. 32 provide direct services; 17 provide indirect services and 11 are government agencies. All but 5 located within the Milwaukee or Madison metropolitan areas.

As of June 2015: 60% of residents live more than 30 miles away from the nearest NHTRC service referral.

#### **Project Outreach Results (As of February 2016)**

*NHTRC Resource Database:* 24 additional Wisconsin-based resources submitted. 20 provide direct services, 4 provide education/outreach. All are located outside the Milwaukee or Madison metropolitan areas.

As of December 2015: 40% of residents live more than 30 miles away from the nearest NHTRC database referral.

**Objective 2: Increase the number of local law enforcement contacts included in NHTRC Law Enforcement Referral Protocol.**

#### **Baseline (June 2015):**

NHTRC Call Protocol for Law Enforcement Referrals includes 3 local law enforcement contacts from 2 agencies in 2 counties (Madison, Milwaukee).

#### **Project Outreach Results as of Feb. 2016:**

19 new local law enforcement agency contacts from 16 agencies in 15 counties identified for inclusion in protocol.
