---

- **Region:**
  - South Central Wisconsin
- **Workforce Challenges:**
  - Childcare and training and
  - Upskilling for in-demand jobs.
- **Solution:**
  - Bolster the pipeline of high-quality childcare professions by leveraging partnerships to provide more care, support childcare facilities in improving quality ratings and accessing financial resources, and support working families with dedicated navigational support at MATC.
  - Develop new avenues to accessing in-demand skills training in advanced manufacturing, healthcare, and information technology through collaborative community partnerships.
