Workgroup Reports:

<u>Domestic Abuse Treatment Standards workgroup report:</u>

New Co-Chairs have been named: Gary Zajc and Bennie Higgins, both from the Alma Center, Milwaukee. The program from Hawaii will present at the February meeting. Elizabeth Lucas provided an overview and history of the workgroup.

<u>Fatality Review Commission workgroup report:</u>

The workgroup continues to work on legislation that supports language for DV survivors. Reviewing perspective on a stand-alone domestic violence piece of legislation or a broader blanket piece that includes DV. Being very deliberate and thoughtful in the process. Courtney Olson reviewed the history of the workgroup and the need for a fatality review initiative.

GAL Guidebook workgroup report:

Final draft has been finished and includes feedback from GAL's and judges. The guidebook focuses on accessibility to GAL's and includes actionable steps, including check boxes. The final draft was sent to the full Governor's Council for the February meeting for approval. Physical copies of the Guidebook will be printed using a grant provided by Court Operations. Next step, after Council approval, is to work on distributing the guidebook.
