On August 4, 2016, the agency screened-in a CPS Report alleging neglect by the child's mother and the child's uncle to the child's 4-year-old half-sister. An assessment was completed by the agency and the allegation of neglect was unsubstantiated.

The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical personnel to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found insufficient evidence to substantiate neglect of the child by the grandmother. The child's 4year-old half-sister and 6-month-old half-brother were determined to be safe and remained with their mother. The family was referred to community services and the agency closed the case upon completion of the Initial Assessment.
