The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical professionals to complete the assessment. The Initial assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse and neglect of the infant by the father and neglect of the infant by the mother. The infant and the infant's 2-year-old half-sibling were deemed unsafe, taken into Temporary Physical Custody, and upon discharge from the hospital were placed with a relative. Child in Need of Protection or Services orders had previously been issued for the infant and the sibling on September 3, 2020, and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services.
