| Description of the incident, including the suspected cause of death, injury or egregious abuse or neglect: On April 6, 2014, the agency received a referral regarding a three-month-old child brought to the hospital with severe burns to his head, anterior trunk, and right thigh. Upon further examination, the child also had rib fractures. Law enforcement was contacted and initiated a criminal investigation regarding the child's suspicious injuries. |
| The mother reported she picked the child up from his father's home, noticed the burns, and confronted the father. The father told the mother the burns were caused from bathing the child the previous night. The father reported he bathed the child in the kitchen sink with a spray nozzle and did not realize the temperature of the water until the child started to make jerking body movements. The mother and the father both denied causing the rib fracture injuries. |
| No criminal charges have been filed in this case, but the investigation remains open. |
| Findings by agency, including maltreatment determination and material circumstances leading to incident: The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical personnel to complete the assessment. The agency found a preponderance of evidence to substantiate physical abuse to the child by an unknown maltreater and neglect of the child by his father. During the course of the assessment, no plausible explanation was provided regarding the source of the child's rib fractures and it was determined that he was in the care of numerous adults during the potential timeframe of these injuries. The child and his three-year-old sibling were deemed unsafe, taken into Temporary Physical Custody, and placed in out-of-home care. A Child in Need of Protection or Services petition was filed and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services. |

A Child in Need of Protection or Services petition was filed and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services.
