Summary of any investigation involving the child, any member of the child's family and alleged maltreater conducted under ch. 48 and any services provided to the child and child's family since the date of the incident:

The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical personnel to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse to the infant by the stepmother and neglect to the infant by the father. Medical professionals diagnosed the infant with Abusive Head Trauma. The Medical Examiner's Office dermined the death was a result of blunt force trauma to the head. The infant's one-year-old sibling and the stepmother's seven-year-old son were deemed unsafe and taken into Temporary Physical Custody and placed in foster care. A Child in Need of Protection or Services Petition was filed for both children and the case
