The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical personnel to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of neglect to the child by the mother. Medical professionals have not determined the official cause of death at this time; however the agency determined that the mother's neglect contributed to the child's death. The child's siblings were deemed unsafe, taken into Temporary Physical Custody, and placed with their biological father. A Child in Need of Protection or Services Petition was filed and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services.
