An assessment was completed by the agency and the allegation of neglect was unsubstantiated. The case was closed upon the completion of the Initial Assessment.

Summary of any investigation involving the child, any member of the child's family and alleged maltreater conducted under ch. 48 and any services provided to the child and child's family since the date of the incident:

The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical personnel to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse to the child by the child's mother's boyfriend. Medical professionals determined the injuries were non-accidental in nature. The agency determined the child and his siblings were unsafe, and initiated a Protective Plan. After the mother's boyfriend was incarcerated and prohibited from contact with the family, the agency subsequently determined that the child and his 5-year-old sister and 8-year-old brother were safe in their mother's care, and the children remained in the home with their mother. Upon completion of the Initial Assessment, the case was opened to provide ongoing case management services.
