On March 10, 2020, the agency screened-out a CPS Report.

The agency collaborated with law enforcement to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of neglect to the child by the mother's former boyfriend. The agency determined the child unsafe, and he was taken into Temporary Physical Custody and placed with a relative. A Petition for Protection or Services was filed for the child, and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services. The agency made arrangements for the child's 4-year-old and 5-year-old half-siblings to stay with a relative. Subsequently, the agency deemed the child's half-siblings' father safe, and the half-siblings were placed in his care. Informal Disposition Agreements were initiated for the 4-year-old and the 5-year-old half-siblings, and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services. The 7-year-old child of the mother's former boyfriend was deemed unsafe, taken into Temporary Physical Custody, and placed with a non-related caregiver. Subsequently, the agency deemed the 7-year-old child's mother safe, and the 7-year-old was placed in the mother's care. The agency closed the case upon completion of the Initial Assessment.
