The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical professionals to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate neglect of the child by the child's father and the relative. The Medical Examiner's Office determined the death to be accidental. The agency deemed the child's sibling unsafe and initiated a Protective Plan with the mother. The child's father and the relative were criminally charged and court-ordered to have no contact with the child's sibling. Subsequently, the mother was assessed as protective, and the child's sibling remained with the mother. The agency closed the case upon completion of the Initial Assessment, and no service referrals were made.
