The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of neglect to the child by the mother and father. The Medical Examiner's office indicated the cause of death is unknown; the autopsy report is pending. The agency deemed the child's sibling unsafe and initiated a protective plan. Subsequently, the Protective Plan was terminated, and the child's sibling was taken into Temporary Physical Custody and placed with a relative. A child in Need of Protection or Services Petition was filed, and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services
