On February 11, 2022, another agency screened in a CPS Report for Alternative Response alleging neglect of the child's now 4-year-old sibling by the father. An assessment was completed by the agency with the determination of services not needed. The case remained open to provide ongoing case management.

On November 3, 2021, another agency screened-in a CPS Report alleging neglect of the child by the mother. An assessment was completed by the agency, and the allegation of neglect was substantiated. A Petition for Protection and Services was filed on December 17, 2021, and the case opened for ongoing case management.

On July 7, 2021, another agency screened-in a CPS Report alleging neglect of the child by the mother and father. An assessment was completed by the agency, and the allegation of neglect was unsubstantiated. The case was closed upon completion of the Initial Assessment.

On May 3, 2019, another agency screened-in a Services Report. The family was referred to community resources.

The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found insufficient evidence to substantiate maltreatment of neglect to the child by an unknown maltreater. The Medical Examiner's Office's preliminary findings indicate the child died as a result of complications from an existing medical condition; the autopsy report is pending. The agency determined the child's sibling safe, and the child's sibling remained in the care of the mother. The agency closed the case upon completion of the Initial Assessment, and no service referrals were made.
