The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse to the child by the mother's significant other. The agency deemed the child and the child's half-siblings unsafe and initiated a Protective Plan. Subsequently, the child and the child's half-siblings were taken into Temporary Physical Custody. The child was placed with his father and the child's half-siblings were placed with an unlicensed relative. Petitions for Protection or Services were filed, and the case
