The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical professionals to complete the assessment. Medical professionals determined the children's injuries were consistent with neglect. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of neglect to the 9-year-old and 7-year-old children by the mother and the mother's significant other and insufficient evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse of the 9-year-old child by the mother. The agency deemed the children unsafe and initiated a Protective Plan. Subsequently, the children were taken into Temporary Physical Custody and placed in a non-relative foster home. Petitions for Protection or Services were filed, and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services.
