The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical professionals to complete the assessment. The Medical Examiner's Office noted no signs of trauma to the infant; the autopsy report is pending. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found insufficient evidence to substantiate neglect of the infant by the parents. The infant's siblings were deemed unsafe, taken into Temporary Physical Custody, and placed in a non-relative foster home. Petitions for Protection or Services were filed, and the case remained open to provide ongoing case management services.
