Description of the incident, including the suspected cause of death, injury or egregious abuse or neglect:

On May 31, 2024, the agency received a report of an egregious incident involving a 14-year-old child who was exposed to a dangerous situation that resulted in significant injuries to his mother. Medical professionals determined the mother sustained non-accidental injuries. Law enforcement was contacted and initiated a criminal investigation. As a result of law enforcement's investigation, the mother's significant other was criminally charged with attempted 1st-Degree Intentional Homicide with a Domestic Violence Modifier; seven Possessions of a Firearm-Convicted of a Felony; and Operate Firearm While Intoxicated. A criminal charge is merely an allegation, and a defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.

Findings by agency, including maltreatment determination and material circumstances leading to incident:

The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical professionals to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of neglect to the child by the mother's significant other. The child was deemed unsafe, taken into Temporary Physical Custody, and placed with relatives. Subsequently, the child was determined to be safe in the care of relatives. The agency closed the case upon completion of the Initial Assessment, and the family was referred to community services.
