The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of neglect of the child by the father. The agency deemed the child unsafe and initiated a Protective Plan. Subsequently, the mother was assessed as protective, and the child remained with the mother. The family was referred to community services, and the agency closed the case upon completion of the Initial Assessment.
