The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical professionals to complete the assessment. The Medical Examiner's Office determined the cause of death was non-accidental. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse to the infant by the father. The agency deemed the infant's sibling unsafe and initiated a Protective Plan. Subsequently, the mother was assessed as protective, and the infant's sibling remained with the mother. The family was referred to community services, and the agency closed the case
