The Division of Safety and Permanence (DSP) has received notification that a child death, serious injury or egregious incident has occurred and maltreatment is suspected, or that a child placed in out-of-home care has died and suicide is suspected.

Date of Incident: 5/20/10

Incident Description:

An infant was seen at the local hospital emergency room with a severe head injury. The hospital diagnosed a skull fracture and brain bleed and airlifted the baby to the University of Wisconsin Children's Hospital where he was admitted to the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit. Maltreatment is suspected in the baby's injuries.
