Dear Chief Clerk Renk and Chief Clerk Fuller:

In compliance with 2009 Wisconsin Act 78, the Child Welfare Public Disclosure Act, please accept the Department of Children and Families' 2016 first quarter report on alleged sexual abuse of children residing in out-of-home care. The attached data addresses reports of alleged sexual abuse for the period January 1 through March 31, 2016, and fulfills the Department of Children and Families' reporting requirements under Section 48.981 (9)(b), Wis. Stats. The following is a summary of the findings in the attached report:

Number of Reported Incidents: 53

Wisconsin child protective services agencies screened in and investigated 53 reported incidents of suspected sexual abuse to 42 children residing in out-of-home care.

Dates of the Incidents:

The 53 reported incidents are estimated to have occurred between July 1, 2015 and March 31, 2016. Because children disclose abuse in different stages, it is common for children to report incidents months or even years after the incident occurred. Furthermore, in cases of alleged abuse involving non-verbal children, dates of alleged maltreatment are often difficult or impossible to determine.

Maltreatment Determinations:

For reported incidents, maltreatment determinations were made for 21 (39.6%) of the reported incidents; 31 (58.5%) maltreatment determinations are pending because the investigations are not complete; 1 (1.9%) had a services determination of services not needed. Of the 21 reported incidents where the maltreatment determination was made, 20 (95.2%) were unsubstantiated (i.e., sexual abuse likely did not occur), and 1 (4.8%) received a substantiation determination signifying a preponderance of evidence that the child victims were sexually abused while placed in out-of-home care.

Nature of Maltreater Relationship:

Regarding the 1 substantiated incident, the relationship of the maltreater was a "sibling(s)/step sibling(s)."

Types of Placement:

The 1 incident of substantiated sexual abuse to children in out-of-home care occurred while the child was placed in a Non-Relative Treatment Foster Home.

Location of Substantiated Incidents:

The 1 substantiated incident of sexual abuse to children residing in out-of-home care occurred in Pierce County.

Ages or Age Group of Children:

Alleged sexual abuse was reported and investigated for children ages 2 to 17 years of age. An incident of sexual abuse was substantiated for 1 child who was 13 years old at the time of the incident.
