The Wisconsin Bureau of Child Support has determined that you owe past-due Receipt and Disbursement fees related to your child/spousal support case. These are fees billed to you each year to cover the cost of maintaining records and processing payments on your child support obligation. This is your notification **that a claim will be filed against your state income tax refunds or credits.** This notice will remain in effect until payment is received on these debts. A claim will also be placed against any **state lottery winnings, amounts for the return of unclaimed property, or disbursements** received from the Department of Administration (DOA) for work done under contract with the state that may be paid to you. This action in no way relieves you of your legal obligation to pay ongoing support and fees as ordered by the court.

Past-due child/spousal support Receipt and Disbursement fees of **\$9,999.99** will be reported to the Wisconsin Department of Revenue (DOR). If you make payments toward these balances, the amount reported to DOR will be appropriately reduced or deleted automatically. If your debt increases, the increase will be filed as a claim against your state tax refund, unclaimed property, or lottery winnings. Any overpayment received will be applied to other past due support debts on the court case including child support, spousal support, medical expenses, support related debts and/or birth costs.

You have a right to contest whether the balances are owed by requesting an administrative review and/or a court hearing. To request an administrative review, write to the Wisconsin Bureau of Child Support at the above address. Please include your name, social security number, case number, current address, and telephone number. Administrative review requests can be made at any time and do not require the presence of an attorney.

You may also request a court hearing. The sole issue at the hearing shall be whether you owe the amount certified for Receipt and Disbursement fees. **At the hearing, you will not be allowed to pursue a modification of the child support order.** The fact that you may have made payments on the amounts certified for past due Receipt and Disbursement fees will not be a defense against an income tax refund intercept. Legal representation may be available from legal services in your area. You have the right to consult with an attorney at your expense, or you may represent yourself.
