RE: Important Influenza Information

The Department of Children and Families is encouraging providers to review the Wisconsin Department of Public Health website regarding influenza information. The WI Division of Public Health's Influenza website <a href="https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/influenza/index.htm">https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/influenza/index.htm</a> contains important and late-breaking information about influenza including an item titled, "*Influenza Risk to Pregnant Women*". On December 6, 2012, Jeffrey P. Davis, MD, Chief Medical Officer and State Epidemiologist for Communicable Diseases and Emergency Response within the WI Division of Public Health, issued a letter stressing the importance of vaccinating pregnant women against influenza.

The Department of Children and Families is recommending that all children in out-of-home care over the age of 6 months obtain an influenza shot.
