Re: Basic Maintenance Foster Care Rates and Kinship Care Rates for CY 2018 and 2019

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this memo is to inform counties of the Basic Maintenance rates for foster care and the payment for Kinship Care as provided in the 2017-19 biennial state budget (2017 WI Act 59).

**BACKGROUND**

The Basic Maintenance rate for foster care and the payment for Kinship Care are the required amounts to be paid per state statute.

**INFORMATION SUMMARY**

As provided in the biennial budget (2017 WI Act 59), the Basic Maintenance rate for Foster Care and Kinship Care for CY 2018 and 2019 will increase by 2.5 percent in each calendar year and are as follows:

<b>Kinship Care (child of any age)</b>	\$238	\$244
<b>Foster Parent Certified at Level 1 (child of any age)</b>	\$238	\$244
<b>Foster Parent Certified Above Level 1 (based on age of child)</b>	See Below	See Below
<b>Child Age 0-4</b>	\$394	\$404
<b>Child Age 5-11</b>	\$431	\$442
<b>Child Age 12-14</b>	\$490	\$502
<b>Child Age 15-18</b>	\$511	\$524

These are also the Basic Maintenance rates to be reimbursed in Adoption Assistance and Subsidized Guardianship payments in CY 2018 and 2019.

**Funds**

Counties can use funding provided in the annual Children and Family Allocations to fund foster care rate payments. Counties should use funding in the annual Kinship Care Allocation of the DCF/County contract to fund kinship care payments.

The revised brochure entitled "Understanding the Uniform Foster Care Rate" is attached below and includes information on the rates and initial clothing allowance.

Additionally, the Department recommends that county agencies provide electronic funds transfer (EFT) to licensed foster parents, including those licensed by private Child Placing Agencies, and Kinship Care providers as a method for receipt of payment of the Uniform Foster Care Rate.

**ACTION SUMMARY**

Agency staff should be made aware of the updated publication to share with foster parents and Kinship Care providers for placements remaining or occurring after January 1, 2018.
