



2024 Amended Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV) Needs Assessment

Purpose

The home visiting needs assessment was updated in 2024 as part of receiving MIECHV funds. The purpose of amended needs assessment is as follows:

- Identify high needs within communities in the state
- Identify quality and capacity of existing home visiting programs

The needs assessment amendment continues to be in line with the 2019 Family Foundations Home Visiting strategic plan. This work will support data-driven decisions in the state's home visiting program.

- All 72 counties and all 11 federally recognized tribes were identified as high need communities in Wisconsin.
- Racial and ethnic disparities were identified in some outcomes in high needs communities.
- There is an unmet need for home visiting in Wisconsin. About 71% of families estimated to be in need are not receiving home visiting services.
