Executive Order

- Conducting a periodic statewide needs assessment concerning the quality and availability of early childhood education and development programs
- Identifying opportunities for, and barriers to, collaboration and coordination among federally- and state-funded child development, child care, and early childhood education programs and services
- Developing recommendations for increasing the overall participation of children in existing federal, state, and local child care and early childhood education programs, including outreach to underrepresented and special populations
- Developing recommendations regarding statewide professional development and career advancement plans for early childhood providers

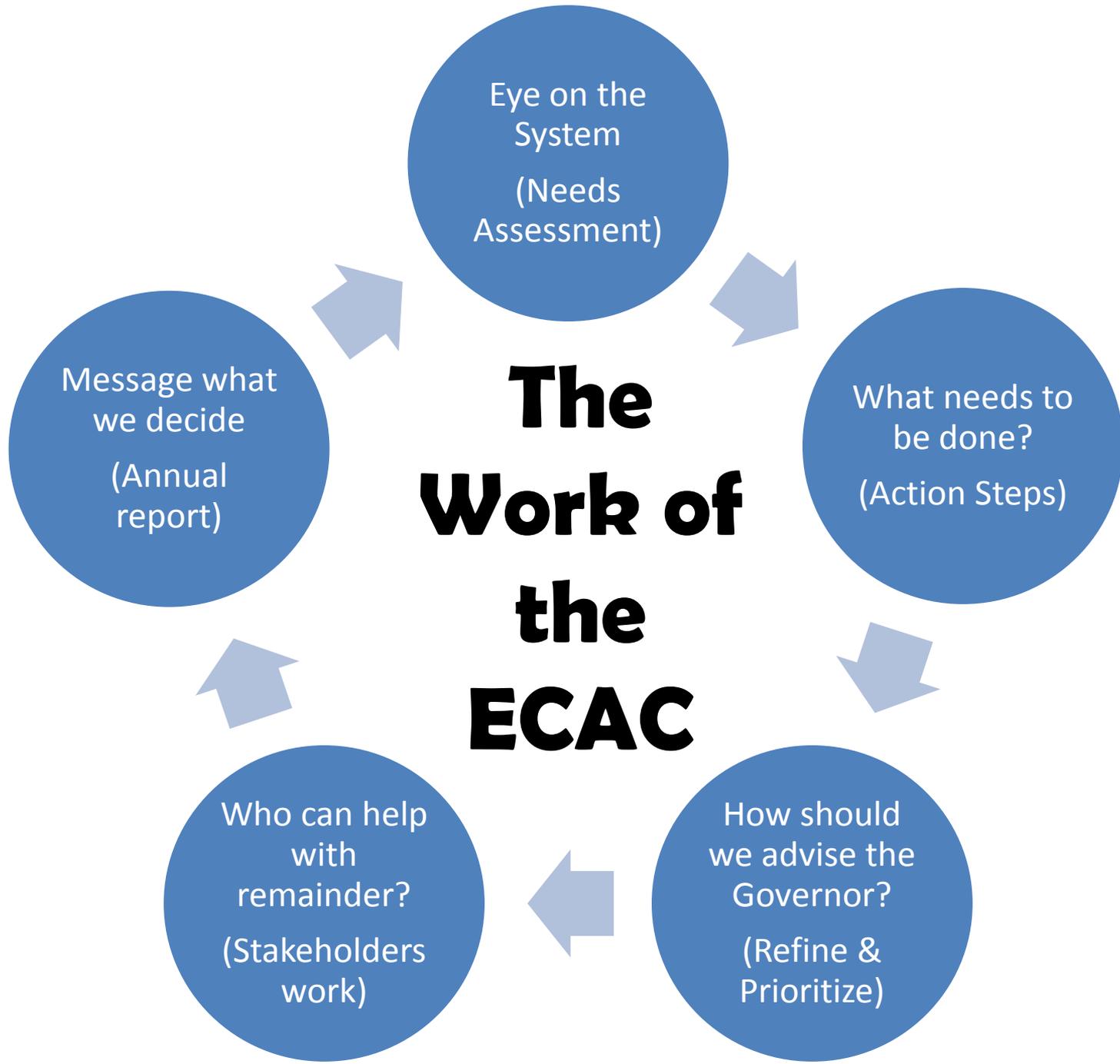

Vision for Today

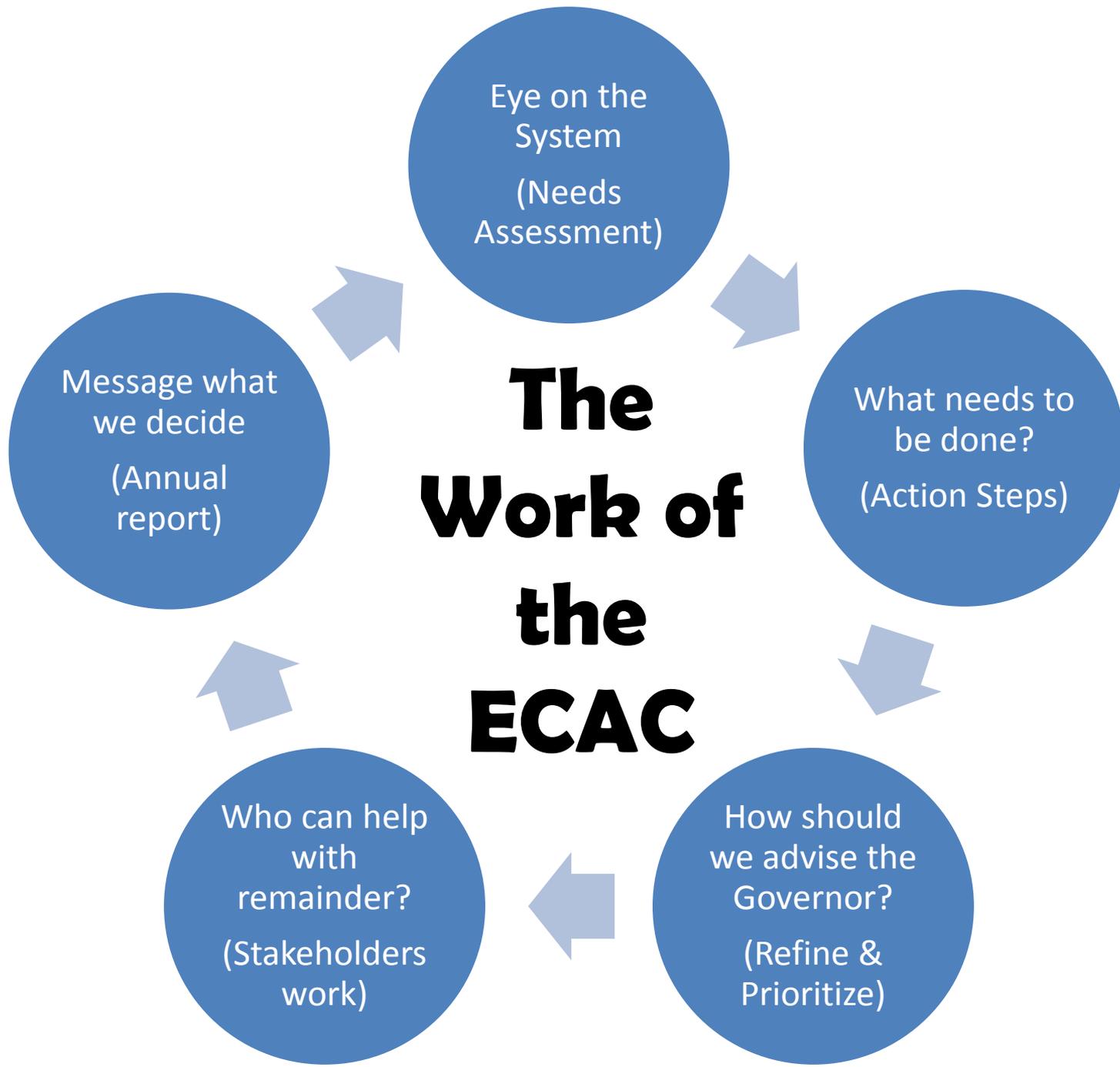
- Working collectively to determine future priorities/actions for the ECAC

Diving into Process: Proposed Levels of Action

- Steering Committee created these levels of action to create clarity around next steps for recommendations/priorities
- The Steering Committee sought input on these at the February 3rd meeting with stakeholders

Proposed Levels of Action

- Recommendation(s) to the Governor
- Recommendation(s) to a State Agency
- Recommendation(s) for all 3 State Agency Leaders (DCF, DPI, DHS, DOC)
- Other ideas for levels of action: national, for the public, legislative, local, for the business sector, individual council member, media, state-level associations

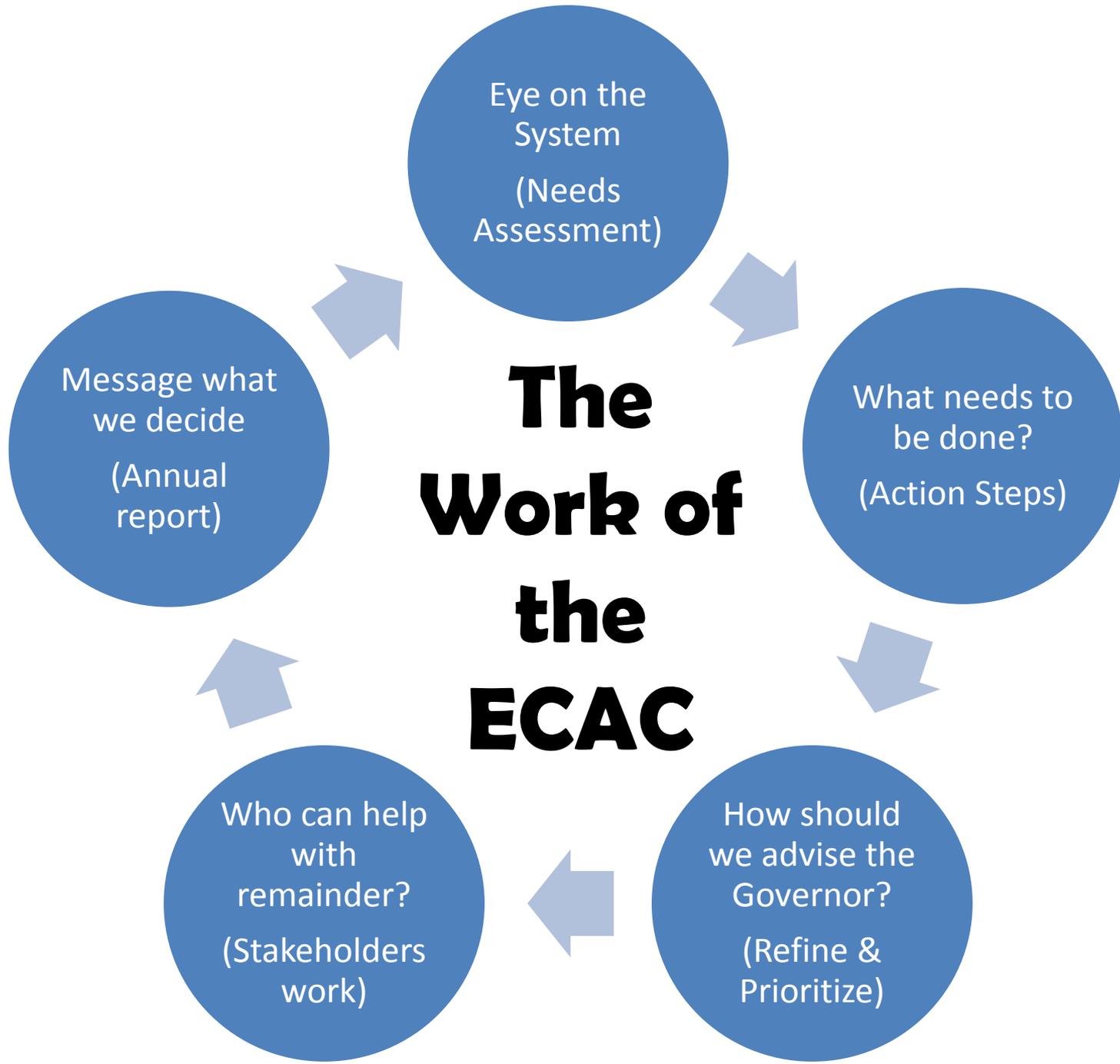
