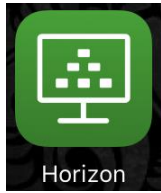
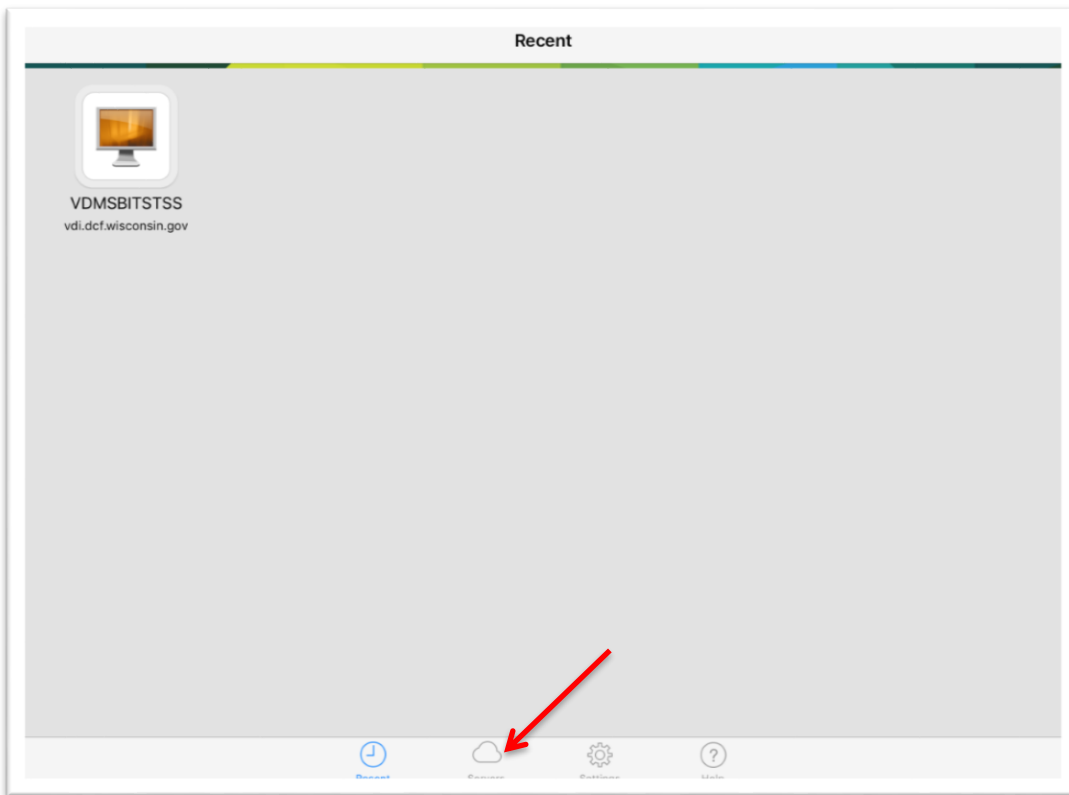


How to Remotely Connect to DCFVDI on iPad (Windows 10)

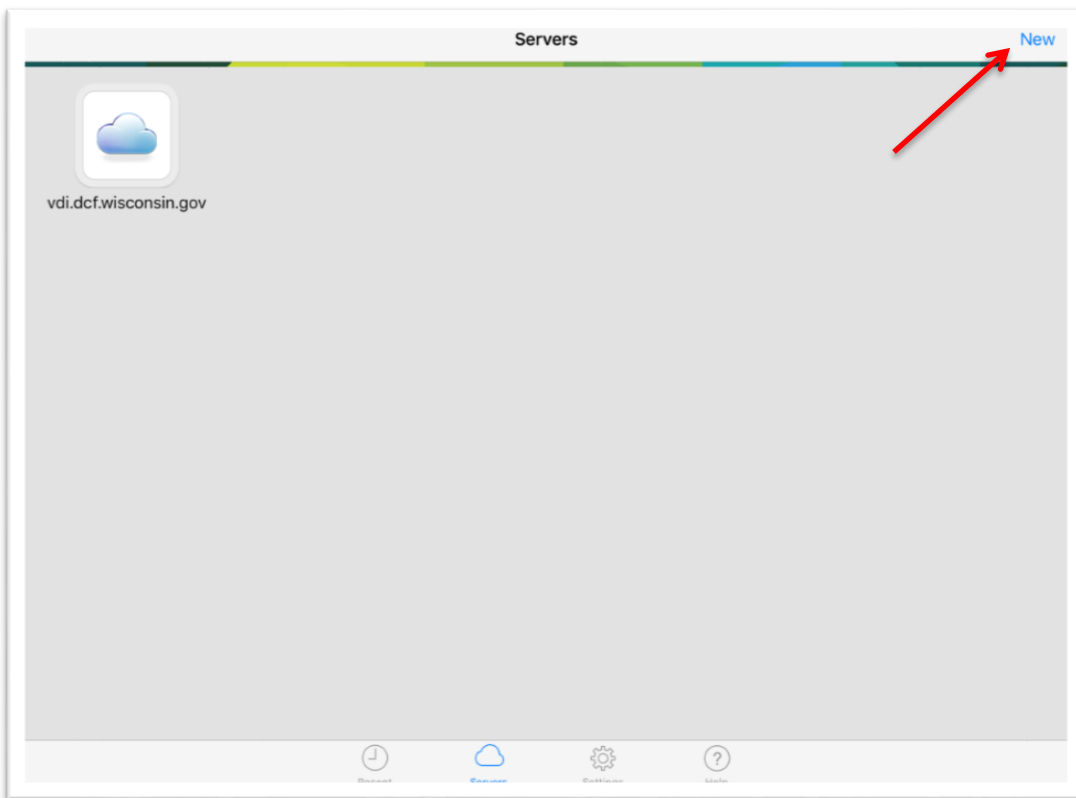
1. Double-click the icon you normally use to connect to your VDI.



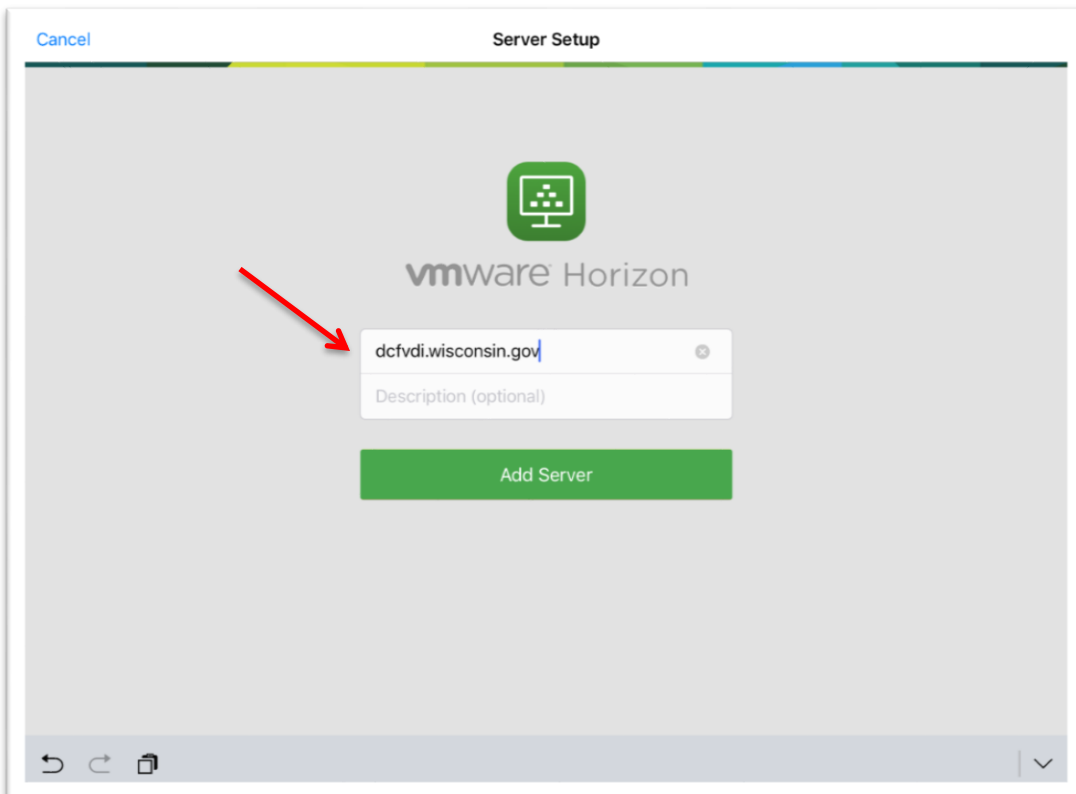
2. This step is only done the first time:
 - a. Tap on *Servers*



3. Tap on *New*.



4. Enter “dcfvdi.wisconsin.gov” in the *Server Address* field. Tap *Add Server*.



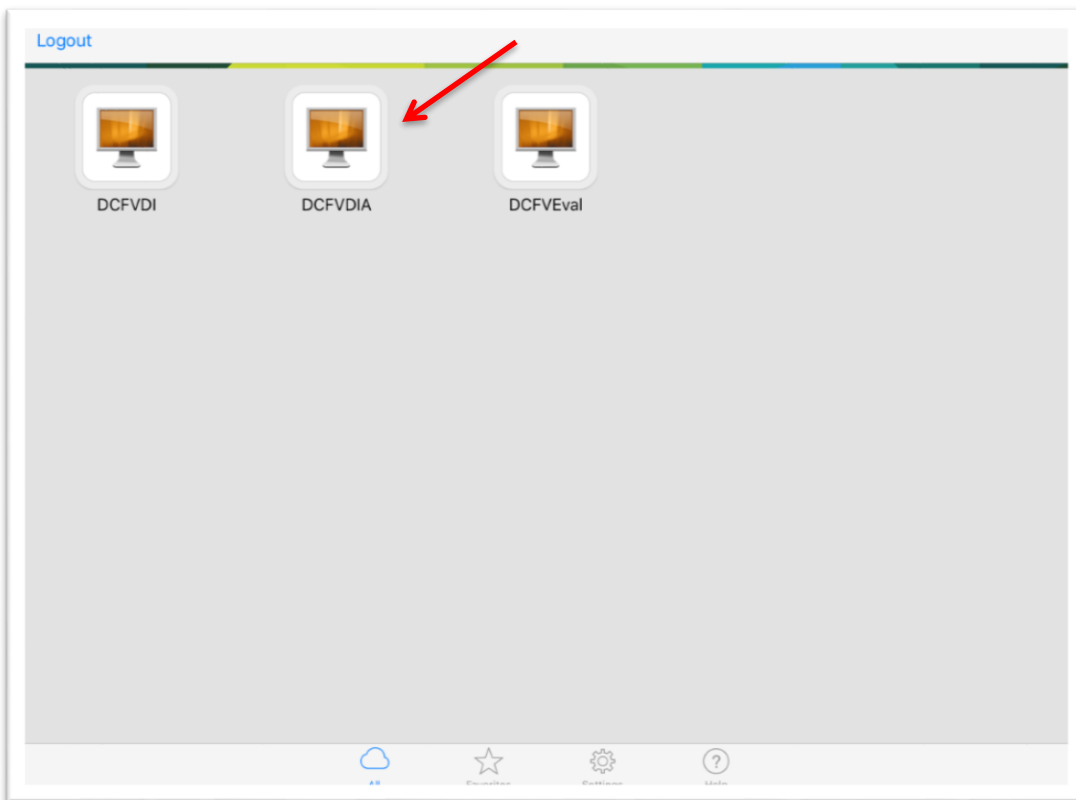
5. This step is your standard Vasco Two-Factor login. Enter your Username and Passcode just like you normally would, except enter your **ACCOUNTS** domain username instead of your **DCFINT** domain username.
