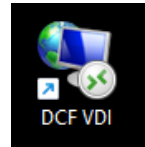


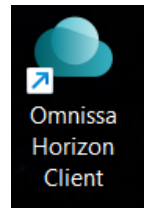
Entra MFA Login to DCF VDI with Yubikey

Connect to your VDI

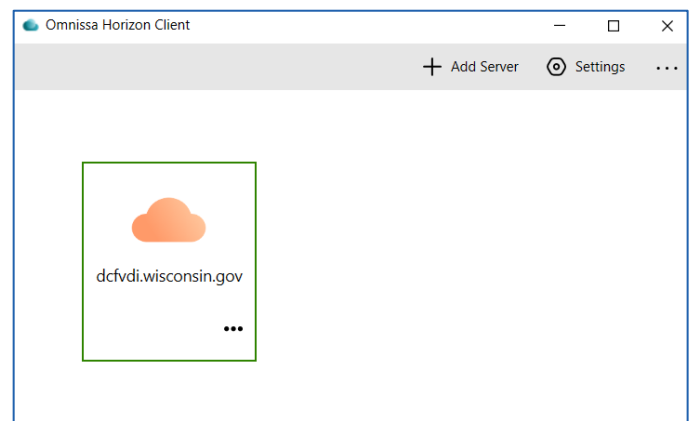
1. Open the Omnissa Horizon Client.
2. If you have a DCF laptop or desktop, double-click the DCF VDI icon on your desktop:
Go to Step 4



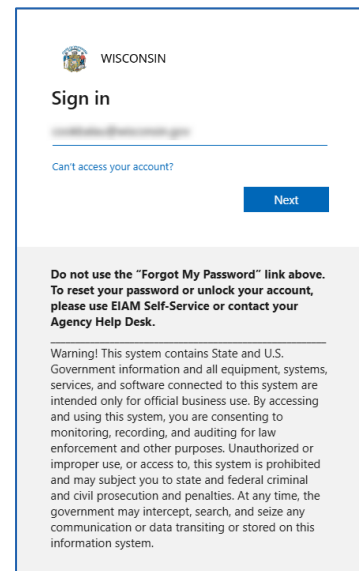
3. If you do not have a DCF laptop or desktop, double-click the Horizon icon on your desktop:




- a. Double-click the **dcfvdi.wisconsin.gov** tile. If you do not see this, click on the "Add Server" button and type in **dcfvdi.wisconsin.gov**. Then double click the cloud icon.



4. A web browser window will open, presenting an Entra login page. Enter your DCF email address and click Next.




5. Enter your password and click Sign In.







7. Choose **Security key** and click next



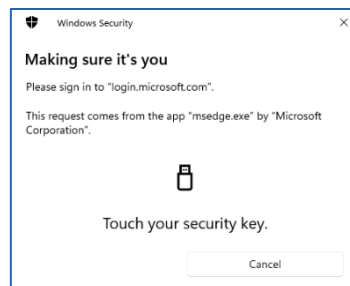

click OK

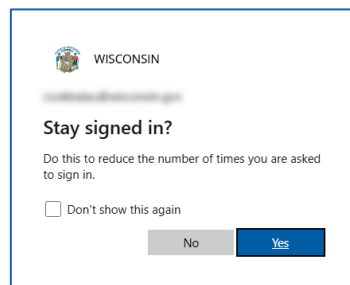

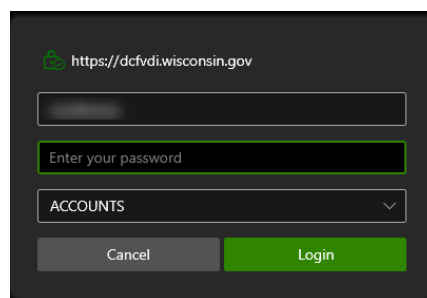
9. Touch your Yubikey



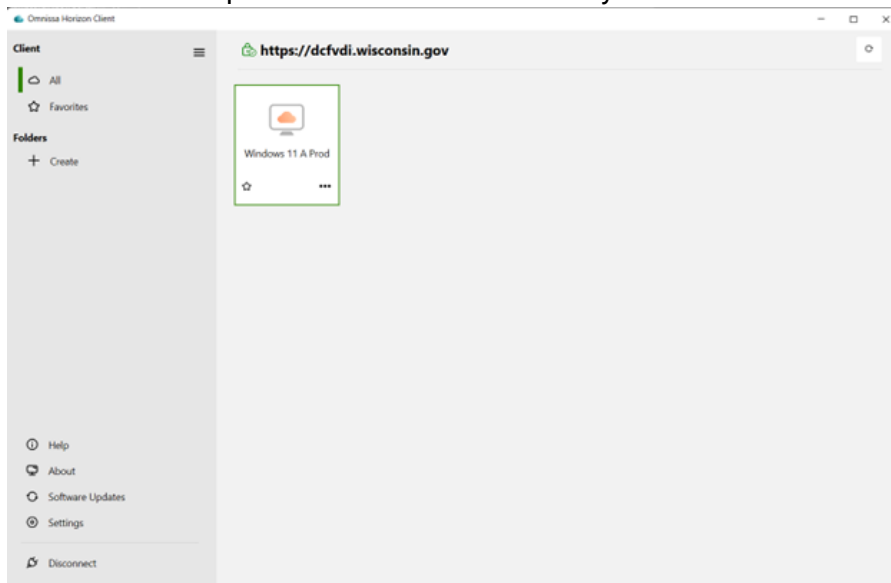
10. At the Stay Signed In prompt, click No
