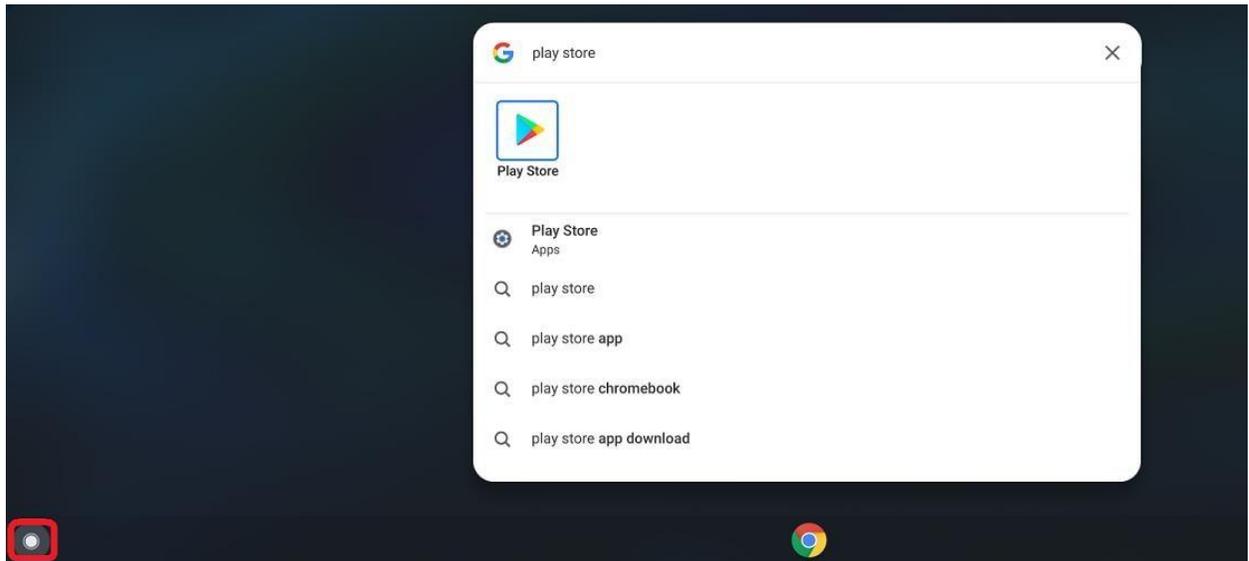


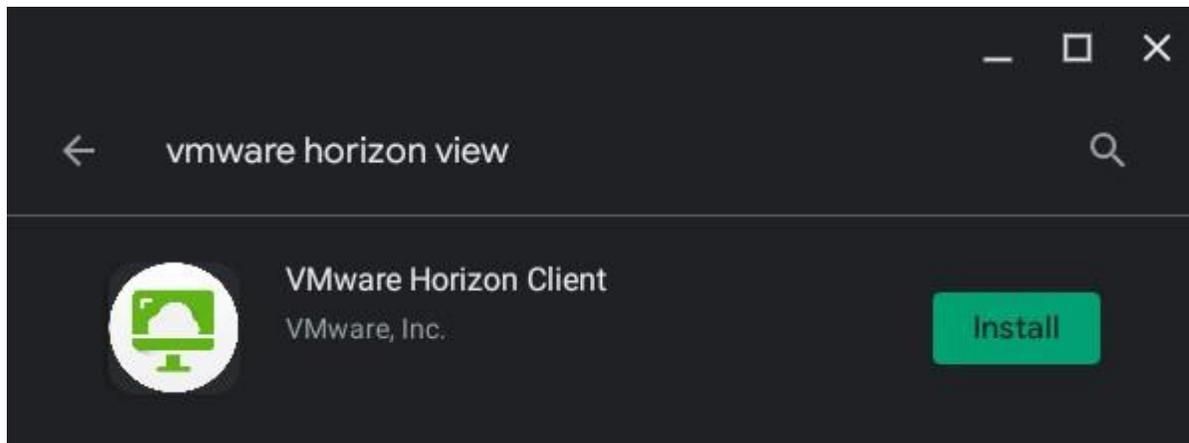
How-To: Set up VDI Access on a Chromebook

Steps to setup the app:

1. Open the Play Store by clicking the circle in the bottom left, then **searching for play store**.



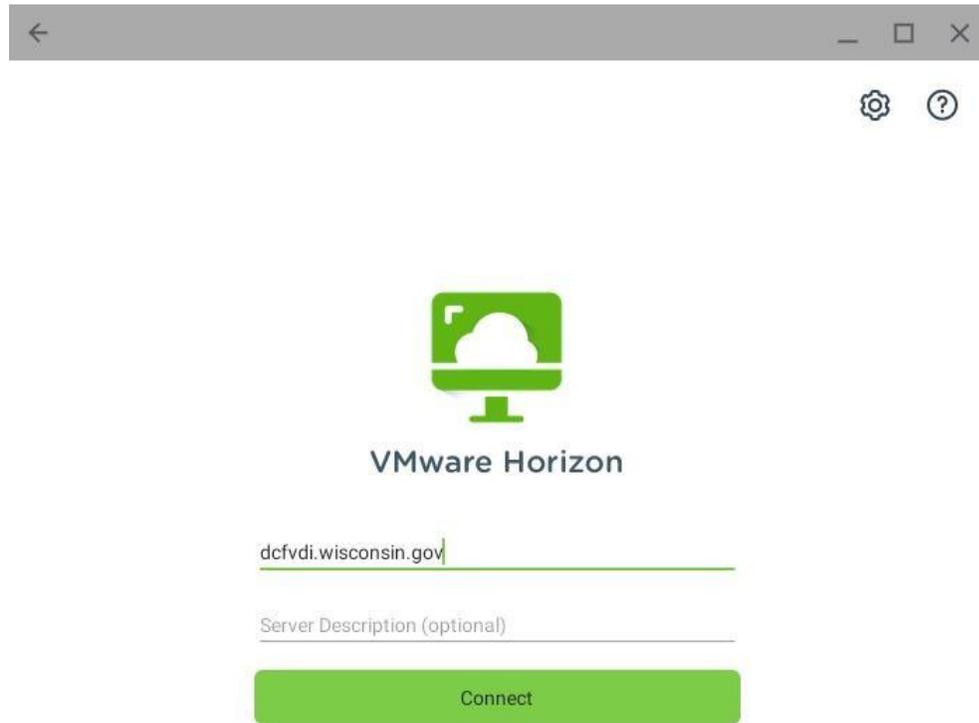
2. Search for **"VMware Horizon View"**



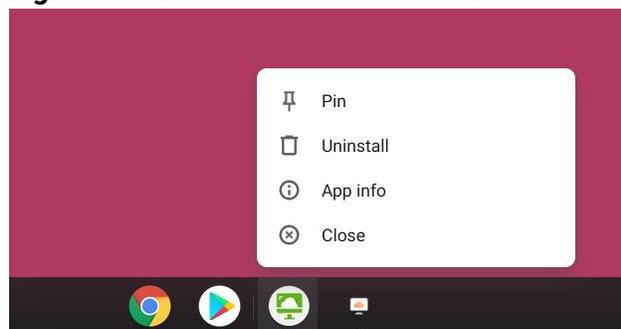
3. Click **Install** to install the app
4. Open the app, you may be prompted to grant some permissions to the app
 - a. Allow Horizon to get the list of your attached USB devices.
 - i. Can **allow or not**
 - b. Allow Horizon to make and manage phone calls.
 - i. **Must allow** for the app to function
 - c. Allow Horizon to access photos, media, and files on your device.
 - i. Can **allow or not**

5. Enter **dcfvdi.wisconsin.gov** for the server address.
 - a. Click **Connect**.



6. **Login** using the [DCF VDI Login with Entra Authenticator App](#) instructions as usual
7. NOTE: The app, by default does not request permission for the microphone or webcam, so you will need to manually enable these if you intend to use teleconferencing programs like Zoom or Teams while connected via the Chromebook.
 - a. **Right click the Horizon icon** in the dock and **select App Info**.

- b. The permissions for Camera and Microphone need to be enabled for teleconferencing
