

## Court Ordered Kinship Service Categories and Types

<b>Service Category: Kinship – Court Ordered</b>	<b>Definition</b>
Kinship Care – Court Ordered	The county has a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child for a placement with a relative that has been approved for Kinship.
Kinship Care – Court Ordered County Funded	The county has a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child for a placement with a relative that has been approved for Kinship, but there are no State Kinship funds available for this placement so the county is funding it.
Kinship Care – Court Ordered-Out-of-State	The county has a court order (with placement and care responsibility for the child) for a placement with a relative that does not live in Wisconsin. This service is a child specific rate.
Kinship Care - Court Ordered (19+)	The county has a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child for a placement with a relative that has been approved for Kinship. This service is used for children over age 19 and under the extension of care to 21.
<b>Service Category: Wrap – Kinship Care – Court Ordered</b>	<b>Definition</b>
Wrap – Kinship – CO County Funded	Wraparound services are being provided, and the county has a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child for a placement with a relative that has been approved for Kinship.
Wrap – Kinship – Court Ordered	Wraparound services are being provided, and the county has a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child for a placement with a relative that has been approved for Kinship, but there are no State Kinship funds available for this placement so the county is funding it.
<b>Service Category: FPI – Kinship Care – Court Ordered</b>	<b>Definition</b>
FPI – Kinship – CO County Funded	FPI services are being provided, and the county has a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child for a placement with a relative that has been approved for Kinship.
FPI – Kinship – Court Ordered	FPI services are being provided, and the county has a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child for a placement with a relative that has been approved for Kinship, but there are no State Kinship funds available for this placement so the county is funding it.
<b>Service Category: YES – Kinship Care – Court Ordered</b>	<b>Definition</b>
YES – Kinship – CO County Funded	YES services are being provided, and the county has a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child for a placement with a relative that has been approved for Kinship.
YES – Kinship – Court Ordered	YES services are being provided, and the county has a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child for a placement with a relative that has been approved for Kinship, but there are no State Kinship funds available for this placement so the county is funding it.

## Voluntary Kinship Service Categories and Types

<b>Service Category: Kinship Care – Voluntary</b>	<b>Definition</b>
Kinship Care–Guardship Order(not 48.977)	The county does <b>not</b> have a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child and the relative has obtained legal guardianship of the child under any statute other than 48.977.
Kinship Care-LT Guardianship 48.977	The county does <b>not</b> have a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child, but the relative has obtained legal guardianship of the child under 48.977.
Kinship Care–Voluntary	The county does <b>not</b> have a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child and the service is funded through normal State apportioned Kinship funding.
Kinship Care-Voluntary County Funded	The county does <b>not</b> have a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child and the service is being funded through county funding.
Kinship Care-Voluntary Waitlist	The county does <b>not</b> have a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child and although the relative has been approved, the service is not paid until funding becomes available.
Kinship Care-Voluntary-Out-of-State	The county does <b>not</b> have a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child and the child is receiving Kinship services in a state other than Wisconsin. This is a child specific rate.
<b>Service Category: Wrap – Kinship Care – Voluntary</b>	<b>Definition</b>
Wrap – Kinship – Voluntary	Wraparound services are being provided and the county does <b>not</b> have a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child and the service is funded through normal State apportioned Kinship funding.
Wrap – Kinship – Voluntary County Funded	Wraparound services are being provided and the county does <b>not</b> have a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child and the service is being funded through county funding.
Wrap – Kinship – Voluntary Waitlist	Wraparound services are being provided, the county does <b>not</b> have a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child and although the relative has been approved, the service is not paid until funding becomes available.
Wrap – Kinship-Guard Order (Not 48.977)	Wraparound services are being provided and the county does <b>not</b> have a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child and the relative has obtained legal guardianship of the child under any statute other than 48.977.
Wrap – Kinship-LT Guardianship (48.977)	Wraparound services are being provided, and the county does <b>not</b> have a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child, but the relative has obtained legal guardianship of the child under 48.977.

FPI – Kinship – Voluntary	FPI services are being provided and the county does <b>not</b> have a court order with placement and care responsibility of the child and the service is funded through normal State apportioned Kinship funding.
