Below you will find highlights for the upcoming October 2024 eWiSACWIS release. These highlights include changes that may affect workflow, data entry, procedures, and reporting. Some of the changes are the result of policy changes, legislative changes, eWiSACWIS team input, and issues reported to the eWiSACWIS help desk by users.

<b>PDS</b>	<p>46163:  <b>Business Purpose:</b> To enhance the Home Provider page, Training tab, for Child Welfare professionals by populating the Home Provider record with training records sent from the Professional Development System (PDS) application.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Updates in Training Tab that will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Training tab has been reactivated in a read-only format to display data housed in PDS.</li> <li>○ The layout of the Course Listing group box is modified.</li> <li>○ The Course Listing group box will now also display external courses the Home Provider takes outside of the PDS application.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>SYNC</b>	<p>46743:  <b>Business Purpose:</b> To Extend SYNC support with the addition of placement referrals to Child Placing Agencies (CPA).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Changed 'Congregate Care Referral' to 'OHC Placement Referral' on all the pages including Create Case Work.</li> <li>▪ Modified the page name from <b>Congregate Care Referral</b> to <b>OHC Placement Referral</b> for all existing and future referrals.</li> <li>▪ Following four documents will be added to the existing list of document types that automatically load upon initial launch of the OHC Placement Referral page. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Child Description for Adoption Recruitment</li> <li>○ Child Description for Foster Home Placement Recruitment</li> <li>○ Info for OHC Providers Part A</li> <li>○ Info for OHC Providers Part B.</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ Child Description for Adoption Recruitment and Child Description for Foster Home Placement Recruitment will be made available to search via 'Document Search' <a href="#">hyperlink</a>.</li> <li>▪ Modifications will be made to the <b>Congregate Care Referral page, Provider Matching Tab</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Adding two expandos to separate the Congregate Care Providers from the Child Placing Agencies.</li> <li>○ Adding the capability to share the referral with Child Placing Agencies.</li> <li>○ Adding the ability to sort the columns in the Selected Child Placing Agencies group box and the Selected Providers group box.</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ A new page <b>Child Placing Agency Selection</b> will be added which will be used to add Private Providers with the Type of Child Placing Agency to the OHC Placement Referral.</li> </ul>

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Modifications will be made to the Finalize Referral page. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Removed the provider’s name and ID on the confirmation message. Now it includes only child/youth Name (Person ID).</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ On the <b>Case Closure</b> page, case closure validation will be added to check for pending OHC Placement Referrals.</li> <li>▪ Modifications will be made to the SYNC – Administration page. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Pop-over message language will be changed for all existing roles.</li> <li>○ Two new roles will be added to manage SYNC security for Child Placing Agency providers.</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ Modifications will be made to SYNC page: Active Referrals page – Active Referral tab, Decision section. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ the Program field is hidden when the Decision is ‘Accept’ for CPA SYNC Providers only.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>OHC Parts A &amp; B</b>	<p>47165: <b>Business Purpose:</b> To provide necessary information to an Out-Of-Home Care Provider to help care for a child/youth in their home or facility with streamlined versions of Parts A and B.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Modifications will be made to Information for Out of Home Providers – Part A – Added: Child/Youth Summary tab <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Visual snapshot of the Child/Youth’s information will be displayed for the providers.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Youth Justice</b>	<p>41233: <b>Business Purpose:</b> To surface accurate, up-to-date data from the Youth Assessment Screening Instrument (YASI) to Youth Justice Professionals in the context of important decisions in a Youth’s case.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A new page <b>YASI Information</b> will be added. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ This page displays a youth’s most recent YASI assessment and case plan data, providing the user insight on the youth’s current status.</li> <li>○ The page will also allow users to upload YASI specific Imaging records to group all YASI documents in one convenient location. These will also display in standard Imaging Search.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>47370, 47371 <b>Business Purpose:</b> To simplify and clarify offense and referral documentation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Location of alleged offense(s) will now be selectable per offense rather than per referral (since locations may differ for charges within a referral).</li> <li>• Referral Type checkboxes will be removed. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ These values will still be calculated behind the scenes to preserve reports functionality.</li> <li>○ ICJ will be selectable and moved to be near the Referral Source area.</li> <li>○ Ord./Civ. Law Violation will be selectable per offense.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>47454 <b>Business Purpose:</b> To enable YJ Professionals to document victim information and generate the Victim Outreach Packet from the YJ Referral page, without needing to first create a Case Information Page.</p>

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The expando will be similar to that on the current Case Information Page.</li> <li>• Victim work documented on the Referral will carry forward to the Case Information Page when the YJ Referral is linked and frozen.</li> </ul> <p>47372</p> <p><b>Business Purpose:</b> To expand the range of scenarios where the 40-day intake task correctly captures outstanding recommendations.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Intake group box includes new fields to clearly capture instances when the prosecutor requests a 20-day extension/investigation, and when this is documented, the 20d clock for the new recommendation is automatically set with a new task.</li> <li>• Referrals reassigned to another county (i.e., when not linked to a Case Information Page) will automatically reset the 40d clock upon reassignment, to ensure adequate time for the new county to complete its recommendation and display 1. the original Date Referral Received and 2. the date and time received by the new county.</li> <li>• Referrals auto generated by a completed Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI) will include a text prompt to ensure the Date Referral Received is accurate in case law enforcement does not send the referral immediately following the detention request.</li> </ul>
