



eWiSACWIS Release Notes


June 11, 2022



On the Participants tab, the Create/View ICWA Record hyperlink was replaced by the ICWA Record column that will highlight a Create hyperlink when an ICWA Record has not been created for a participant under age 18.</p>

Provider	<p>44259: A new field named “Address Search” was added to validate new addresses entered on the Create Mailing Address Provider, Create Physical Address Provider, Maintain Mailing Address, and Maintain Physical Address pages. The Address Search field looks up addresses as they are being typed to allow for the quick selection and pre-fill of the most accurate address information. A “Map this address” hyperlink displays, which opens a Google map with the address pinpointed.</p>

Technical (For county/agency IT contacts)	<p>44262: To remain on a secure, current, and supported database platform, the eWiSACWIS Oracle databases were upgraded from Oracle 12.2 to Oracle 19c and moved to updated server nodes. In addition to the database version changing, the version of database time zone file migrated from 14 to 36. Some installations also needed to upgrade their local time zone version to maintain compatibility with the import process.</p>
