



# How To Install eWiSACWIS OCX Files for Windows Vista


1. Click Start > Control Panel




## 2. Click on User Accounts




3. Click on User Accounts (again)




4. Click on Turn User Account Control on or off (last option). You will get a pop-up asking that if you started this action, continue. Click Continue on this pop-up message.




5. Uncheck 'Use User Account Control (UAC) to help protect your computer' and click OK.




6. Click Restart Now to restart your computer.



7. After restarting your computer, open Internet Explorer and go to eWiSACWIS (<http://apps.dhfs.state.wi.us/ewisacwis/>). You will see the following information bar message near the top of the page: “This website wants to install the following add-on: ‘eWiSACWIS Document Template MS Word Control’ from ‘State of Wisconsin’ . If you trust the website and the add-on and want to install it, click here...”. Click on it.



8. You will receive the following message. Click the arrows pointing down button next to ‘More options’.



9. Select Always install software from “State of Wisconsin” and click Install. All eWiSACWIS files have been installed.



10. To turn User Access Control back on, follow steps 1-6 above, except in step 5 check the ‘Use User Account Control (UAC) to help protect your computer’ checkbox.
